Abstract

This IL provides industry notification of an extension in the permissive dialing period for the 206/360 NPA split.

We have been advised by US WEST that the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission has ordered a 90-day extension to the permissive dialing period. The previously published date for the end of permissive dialing was Sunday, May 21, 1995. The new date to begin mandatory dialing of the 360 NPA is 12:01 AM PDT on August 20, 1995. The previously announced jeopardy situation will remain in effect throughout the extended permissive dialing period.

US WEST has also indicated that Central Office codes assigned in the 206 and 360 NPAs which were originally scheduled for nationwide activation between June 5, 1995 and September 2, 1995 will have their activations postponed until September 3, 1995 or later. The June issue of the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) will reflect these changes.
