Dear Paul,

San Diego is providing switching capacity relief for San Bernadino by assuming the terminating screening office function for 800 854 on August 19, 1978, as noted in both ARGIS and the TRG. However, extraordinary circumstances necessitate the issuance of this letter to provide special routing instructions which are required to assure maximum relief for the San Bernadino and to avoid overloads on the San Diego switching systems.

Inward WATS traffic (800 854 + 4D and 08B 854 + 4D) that has to be delivered to San Bernadino on direct trunks, should be sent on the same basis as is required by San Diego i.e., 12B + 4D. In other words, when forwarding Inward WATS traffic directly to SNBOCA0133T for completion by SNDGCA0787T. Suppress the 08B 854 + 4D format that would normally be sent to a "VIA" office and send 12B + 4D to San Bernadino as though it were also a terminating screening office.

This may involve special measures to accomplish, for example, in 4A ETS additional route pattern indexes will be required for the originating screening office function and also for the tandem or via office function.

Please make every effort to establish this routing correctly as it is critical for the avoidance of major network blockages.
