Dear j:

On March 17, 1979 Oklahoma City 4A ETS will start phasing out of operation. It is being replaced by a 4 ESS which does not have the capability of providing the loop-around arrangement necessary for the 191 + NPA dialing procedure. You will, I'm sure, recall the Conference Operator satellite avoidance procedures described in GL 76-09-120 dated September 17, 1976 and the routing information letter dated August 16, 1976.

When the Oklahoma City 4A ETS is discontinued there will be no reasonable substitute for the 191 + function and an alternative must be provided until such time as a fix in the 4 ESS can be developed. The interim solution is for all switchers (routing 191+) except those in the Dallas region to redirect the calls destined for the Dallas region to their home region switch that handles 191+. In other words, 191+ 214, 405, 512, 713, 806, 817, 915 or 918 should not be sent to Oklahoma City (OKCYOKCEL4T) but rather to the switch in your own region that performs that particular function i.e.

(In the Dallas region (only), 191 will not be functional and the code should be routed to VCA. The effective date for the VCA treatment should be on or after 03/17/79.

(All other regions should implement the routing change to direct 191 + NPA to their home region switch on or before 03/17/79.
