Dear :

This is to advise you of a routing change which must be made on October 6, 1979 to maintain conference satellite avoidance call handling ability in the Pittsburgh region.

On October 6, 1979, the 4A XB switching systems in Pittsburgh will be phased out and with them goes the 191 loop-around trunks. Spare equipment has been sent to Detroit to provide for this function. Completion is planned by the end of September and it shall be available by 10/6/79. Therefore, effective 2:00 P.M. (ET) on October 6, 1979, Detroit will handle the 191 function for the Pittsburgh region. Re-direct that 191 traffic (that you are sending to Pittsburgh) to DTRTMIBA40T. There is a slight change in the NPA codes however, 191+412 which you are now directing to a switch in your home region should go to DTRTMIBA40T and 191+313 should go to the switch in your home region.
