This letter is to advise you of up coming routing changes involving distance dialing to additional countries and to enlist your assistance in providing for IDDD/IOTC testing capabilities.

New test procedures have been established to assure that translations in end offices, TSPS, and toll offices have been set up correctly. The tests will be conducted by, or under the direction of, Facility Managers for TSPS and Dial Administrators for the ESS offices involved in the IDDD/IOTC cutover of 10 countries:

American Samoa	Liberia
Bolivia	New Caledonia
French Antilles	Panama
Guyana	Paraguay
Indonesia	Roumania
Aruba (remainder)	

(Sri Lanka's involvement was cancelled 10/19/79) on February 16, 1980. It is apparent that sufficient time should be allowed for testing and it is therefore felt that the recent changes for all toll offices should be implemented by January 19, 1980.

It would be appreciated if you would see to it that your portion of the toll network is capable of routing the new codes on or before January 19, and the end offices by February 2, 1980. As always, call me if you have any questions.
