Dear Sally,

On July 5, 1980 we are planning to divest STLSM00914T of the 191+NPA responsibility and make COVL1LCL41T the serving office for the St. Louis Region..

This means that you may have to (if not already doing so) 6D translate 191 and route traffic to distant Regions. In effect, as of July 5, you should route

- 1) 191 + NPA(S) in White Plains Region (exc. 914) to WHPLNY0201T
- 2) 191 + NPA(S) in Wayne Region (exc. 717) to HRBGPAHA41T
- 3) 191 + NPA(S) in Pittsburgh Region (exc. 313) to DTRTM1BA04T
- 4) 191 + NPA(S) Atlanta Region (exc. 404) to ATLNGANW43T
- 5) 191 + NPA(S) Norway Region (exc. 815) to NRWYILNO41T
- 6) 191 + NPA(S) Sacramento Region (exc. 415) to OKLDCA0341T
- 7) 191 + NPA(S) San Bernardino Region (exc. 714) to SNBOCA0133T
- 8) 191 + Dallas Region to Collinsville 191 loop-around group
- 9) 191 + Denver Region to Collinsville 191 loop-around group
- 10) 191 + NPA'S excepted above (717, 313 etc.) to Collinsville 191 loop-around group

This will require a new, separate group of loop-around trunks dedicated to the 191 function. If you have any questions at all, please give me a call 201-221-4759.
