Dear ,

This may be considered a Post Script to my letter of February 25, 1981. It appears necessary to clear up some misconceptions about the new Mexico dialing arrangement which was discussed in that letter.

Background information was given which established the need for 190 XXX +. The TSPS generic 10.2 was mentioned along with the date of initial installation of April 27, 1981. Please do not assume that because there is no generic of that vintage going in within your territory, that the new routing will not be required. It probably will be needed. It appears now that cordboard operations are to be changed to the new dialing arrangement on April 27, 1981.

The last line of the Mexico item in my letter stated "Remember, the new routing must be added by April 25, 1981". This still holds and I can see no reason to change it or make it a slow implementation. Do it by April 25, 1981.
