Dear j:

General Letter 76-09-120 dated September 17, 1976, advised of a means by which operator established conference calls could avoid satellite trunks. It was therein recommendation that "loop-around" trunks be installed at Regional Centers to provide for the avoidance routing. The letter excluded Dallas and substituted Oklahoma City 4A. This occurred because the 4A at Dallas was being replaced by a #4ESS and the 4E generics have not been developed for this feature.

Since that time, other 4ESS(s) have been scheduled to replace 4A(s) at the Regional Centers and it has become necessary to designate an alternate to handle the satellite avoidance conference arrangement. Listed below are the offices which will perform the function and the present schedule for service:
