Resolved Issues

- **Site Recovery Manager pairing fails with a timeout and the logs show invalid credentials errors**

When you attempt to pair two Site Recovery Manager instances, the pairing detects a federated environment and fails with an error: "SRM server cannot complete a pair operation. The reason is: Operation timeout". The logs list the following error: "Failed to connect: --> N9SsoClient27InvalidCredentialsExceptionE Authentication failed: Invalid credentials"

This issue is fixed in Site Recovery Manager 8.3.1.1.

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
