## Start Here

- Using a computer that is connected to your modem, insert the enclosed CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- The Welcome screen will appear.
- Click the Installation Wizard button and follow the on-screen instructions.

Note: The CD wizard is not compatible with Mac/Apple computers. Please refer to the User Manual (pages 10 – 15) for detailed information or this QIG (steps 1 – 8) for illustrated cabling instructions.

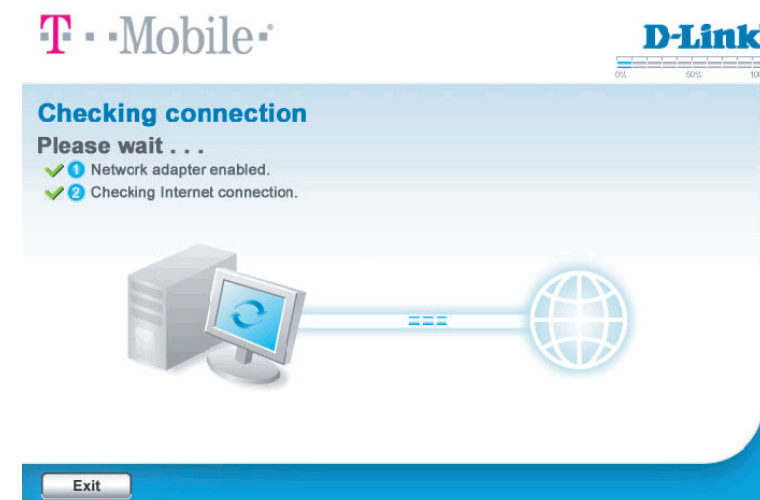

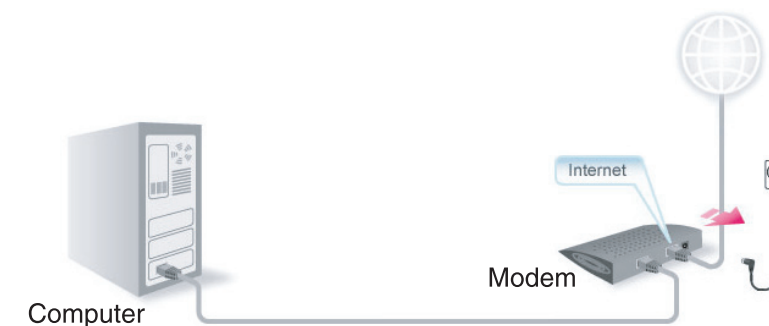
## Checking Connection



\* If the CD detects you already have a wireless router or a Cable/DSL modem with a built in wireless router, the following flow may be different.

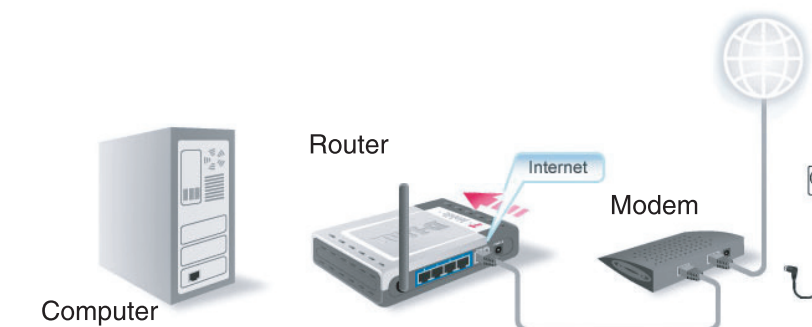
## 1 Power Off Modem

If there is no on/off switch, then unplug the modem's power adapter.



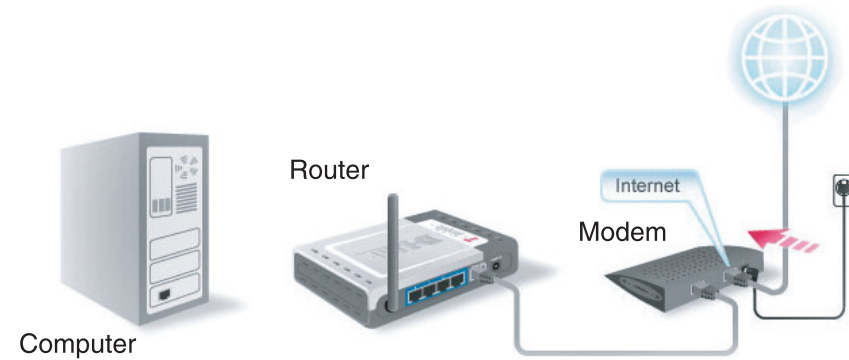
## 2 Disconnect Your Modem From Your Computer and Connect the Modem to Your Wireless Router.

Unplug network cable from PC and plug it into the wireless router's Internet port.



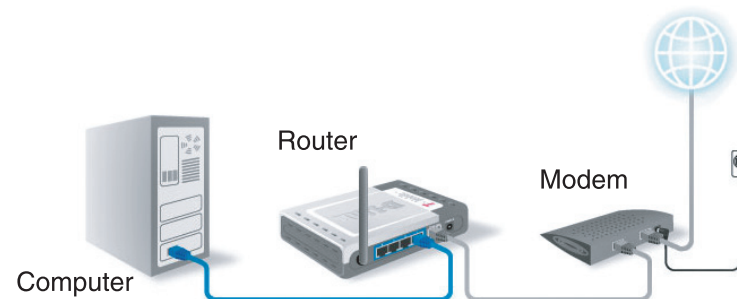
### 3 Power On Your Modem

Plug the power adapter into the port on the back of the Modem.



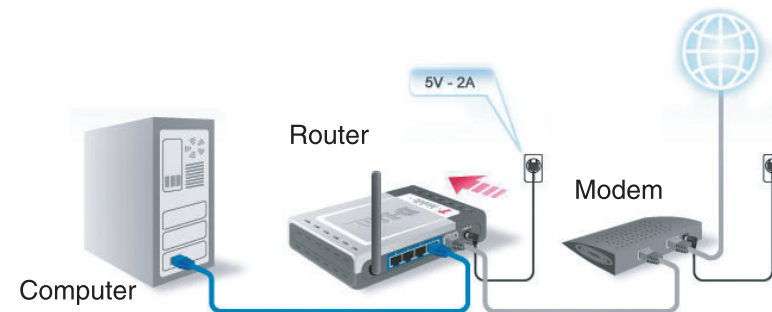
### 4 Connect the Wireless Router to the Computer

Using the Blue network cable that come with your wireless Router, connect one end into any Port 1-4 on the Wireless Router. Connect other end to computer's network port.



### 5 Plug in the Wireless Router

Plug the power adapter into the port on the back of the Wireless Router. Plug the other end into an electrical outlet or power strip.



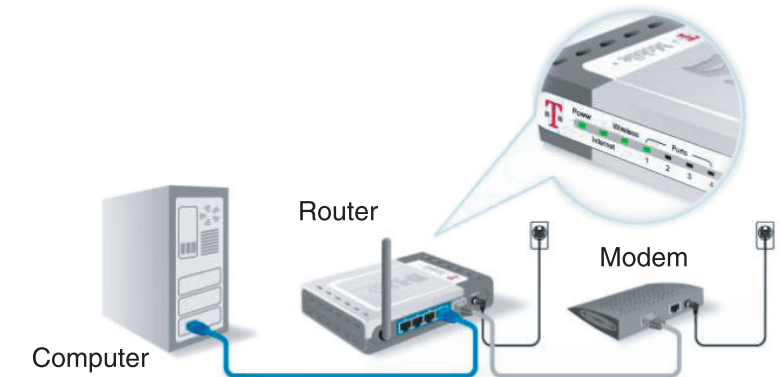
### 6 Observe the Wireless Router Lights

On the wireless router the lights for Power, Internet, and one of the numbered ports 1-4 should be lit. If not lit, confirm all cables are securely connected.



### 7 Confirm your cables are set up correctly

If not, select back and review the cabling instructions.



### 8 Continue with the Installation Wizard on-screen instructions to complete your wireless router's set up. For advance configuration help, please refer to the manual located on the CD.
