With the PowerLine AV 500 Adapter Starter Kit, you can share high speed connections of up to 500 Mbps for quality gaming, superior HD media streaming and faster file transfer.

### Recommendations

- For optimal results, use in a regular wall outlet without any other product plugged into the same outlet.
- Connecting this product to a power strip or a surge protector may adversely affect the performance of this product.
- Avoid using the PowerLine AV 500 Adapter in an electrical outlet that is located near an appliance that uses a lot of power, such as a washer or dryer or a refrigerator.

### Hardware Installation

#### Step 1

Plug the Powerline AV 500 Adapter into an AC wall outlet.

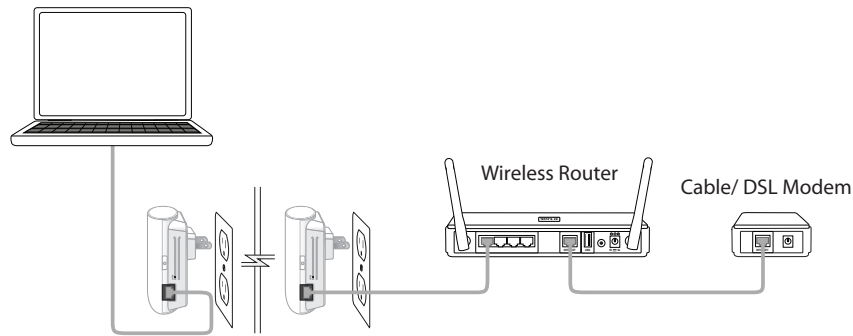
**Note:** Power source is confirmed when the green LED Power Indicator on the Powerline AV 500 Adapter is illuminated.

#### Step 2

Connect the included Ethernet cable to the network cable connector located on the Powerline AV 500 Adapter and attach the other end of the Ethernet cable to a device in the network or a computer.

**Note:** Network Connectivity is confirmed when the PowerLine and Ethernet LED indicators on the Powerline AV 500 Adapter are illuminated.

**Note:** A minimum of two D-link PowerLine AV devices are required to create a PowerLine Network.
