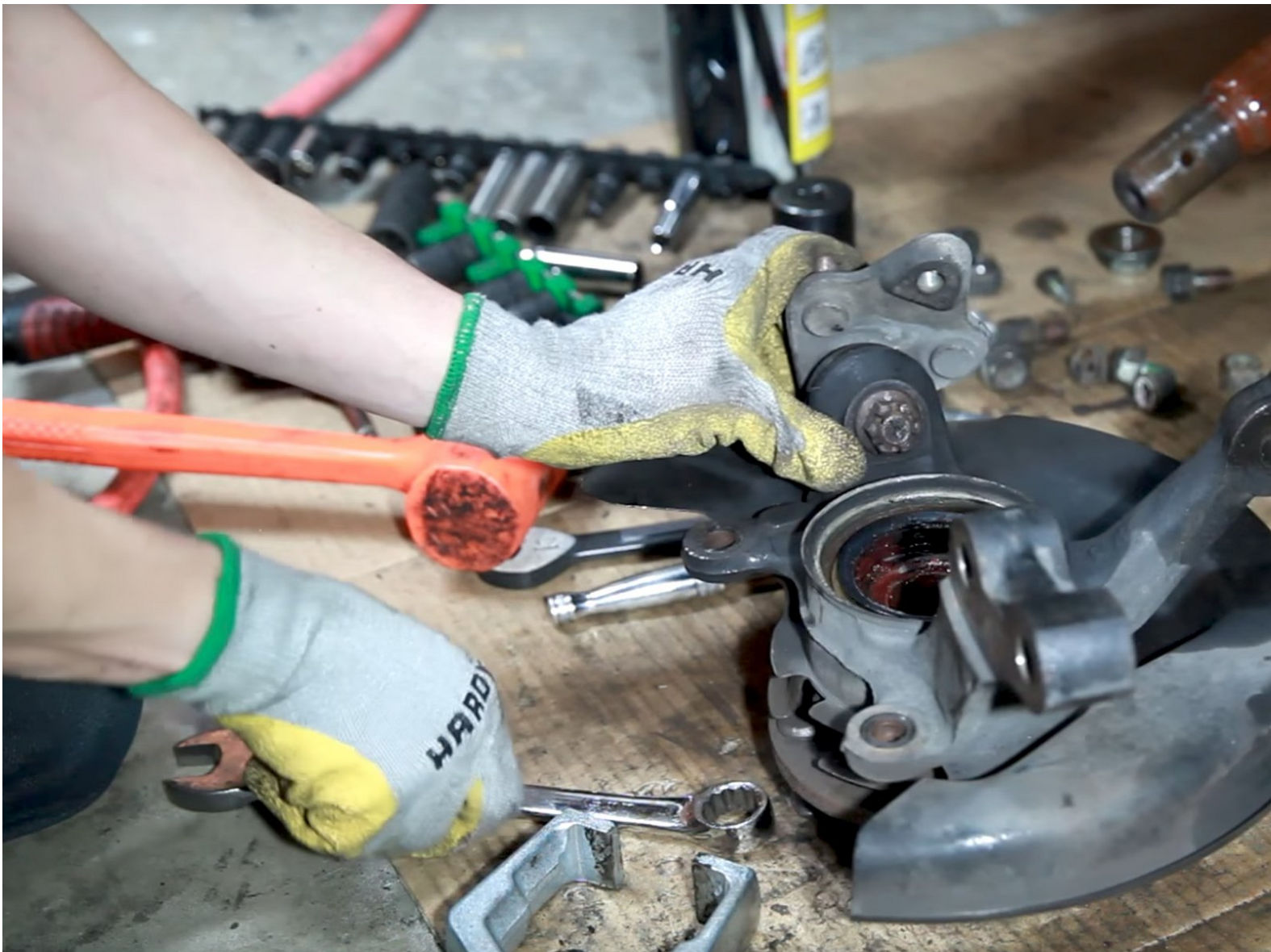




1993-1997 Toyota Corolla Lower Ball Joint Replacement
