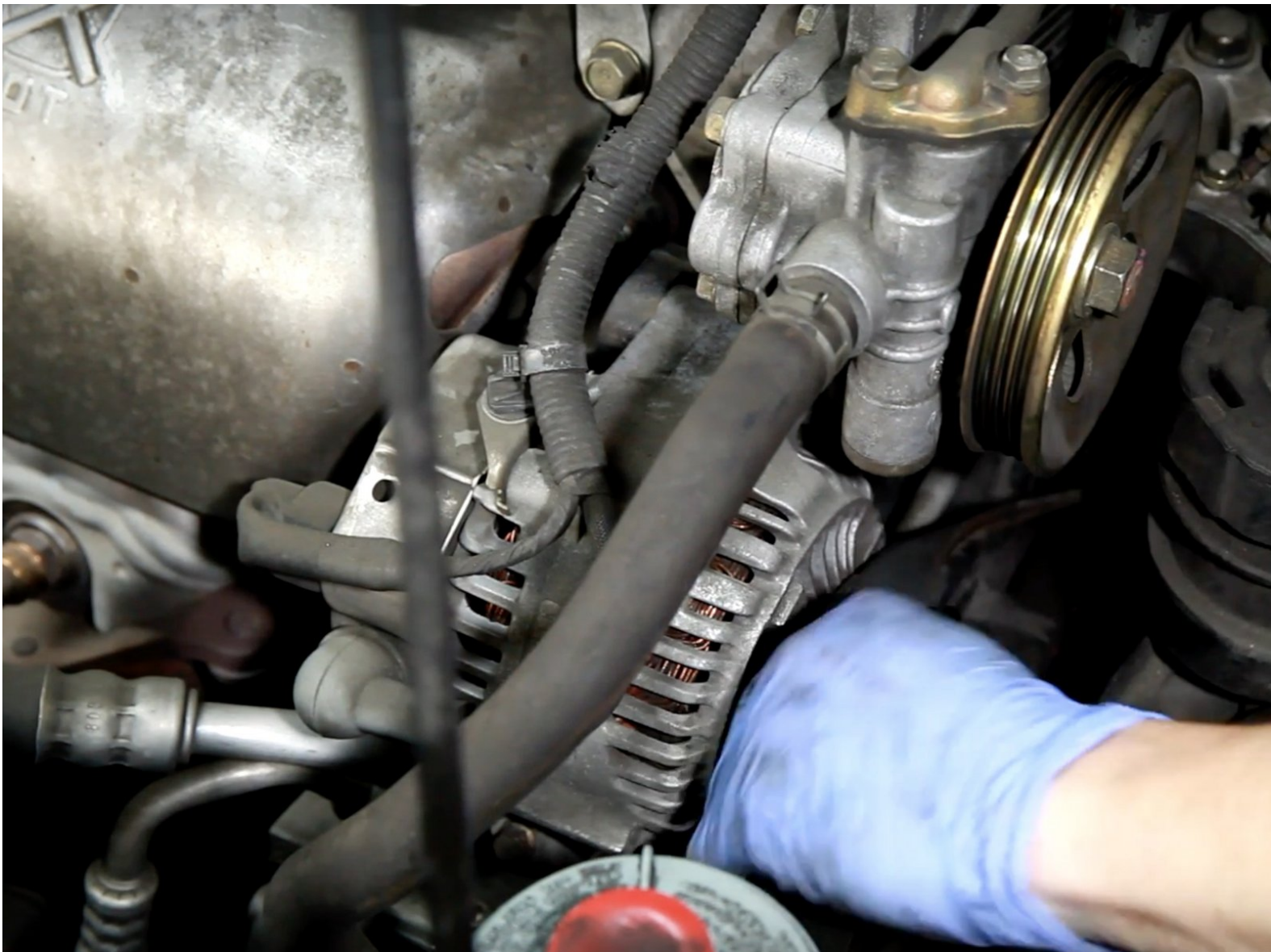




1998-2002 Honda Accord Drive Belt Replacement
