




# 1999-2004 Volkswagen Golf Air Filter Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

Replace a dirty engine air filter to make your car happy.


### TOOLS:

- Locking Pliers (1)
- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)

### PARTS:



- Volkswagen Golf Air Filter (1)

## Step 1 — Air Filter



- Using a vise grip, grip the metal ring securing the intake tube to the air filter cover.
- Slide the ring up the tube.

## Step 2



- Unplug the cable from the air filter.

## Step 3




- Pull the intake tube off of the air filter cover.

## Step 4




- Unscrew two Phillips screws located behind the air filter.

## Step 5



- Lift the air filter cover up, starting from the back end, making sure to release them from the hinges on the front end.

## Step 6



- Remove the air filter.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
