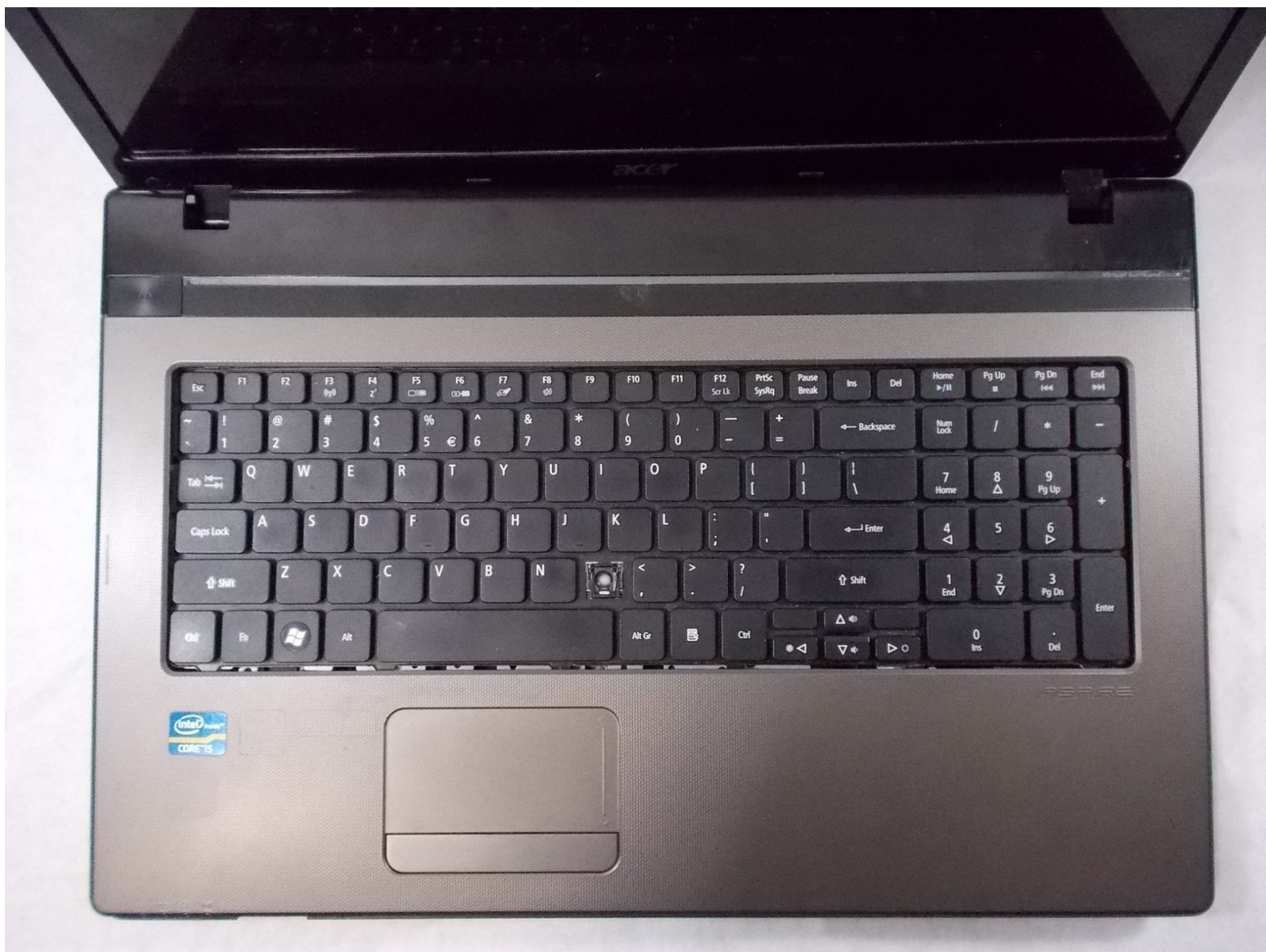




ACER Aspire 7750G-6645 Keyboard Replacement

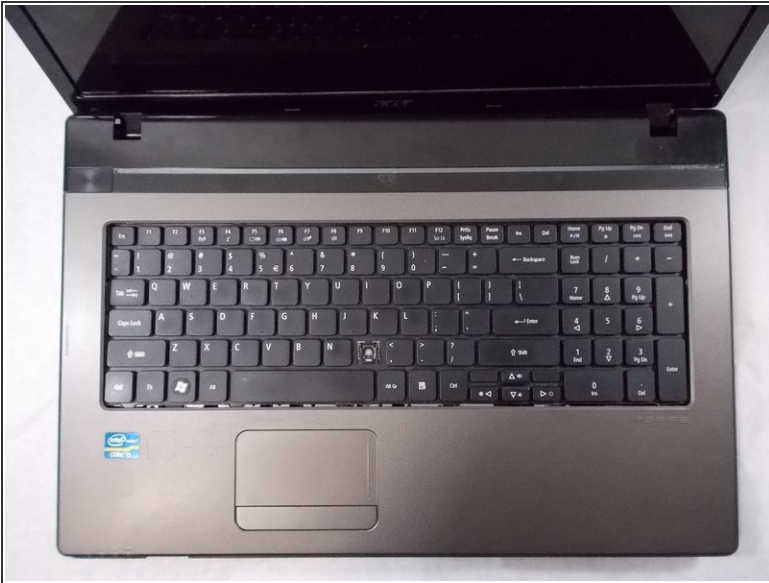

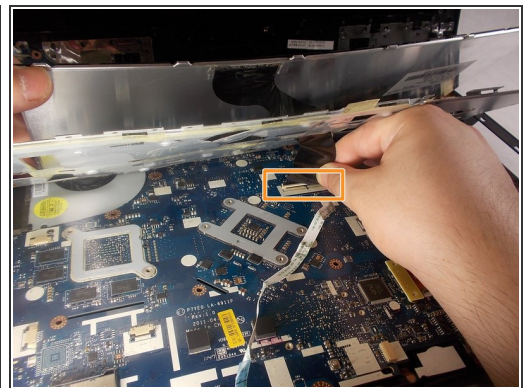
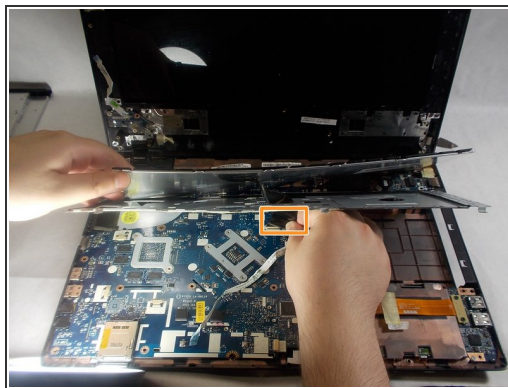

Step 1 — Keyboard



- Turn off the laptop, and open the lid.
- Separate the first two layers by prying them apart, using a spudger.

Step 2



- Lift the keyboard, so that its ribbon is visible.
- Remove the ribbon from the board by using a small metal spudger or flathead screwdriver. (if needed)

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
