INTRODUCTION

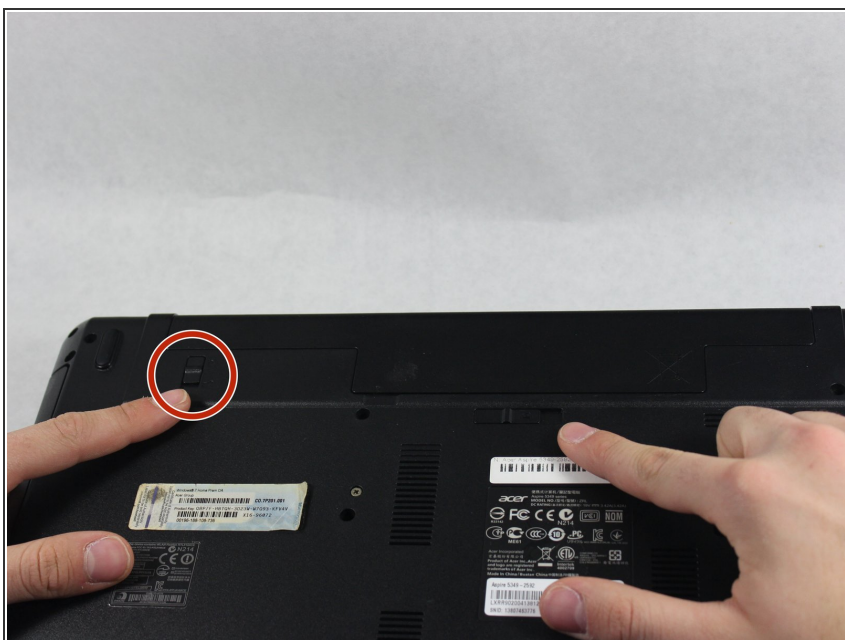
- [Flathead Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Turn the laptop over so that the back is facing you.

Step 2



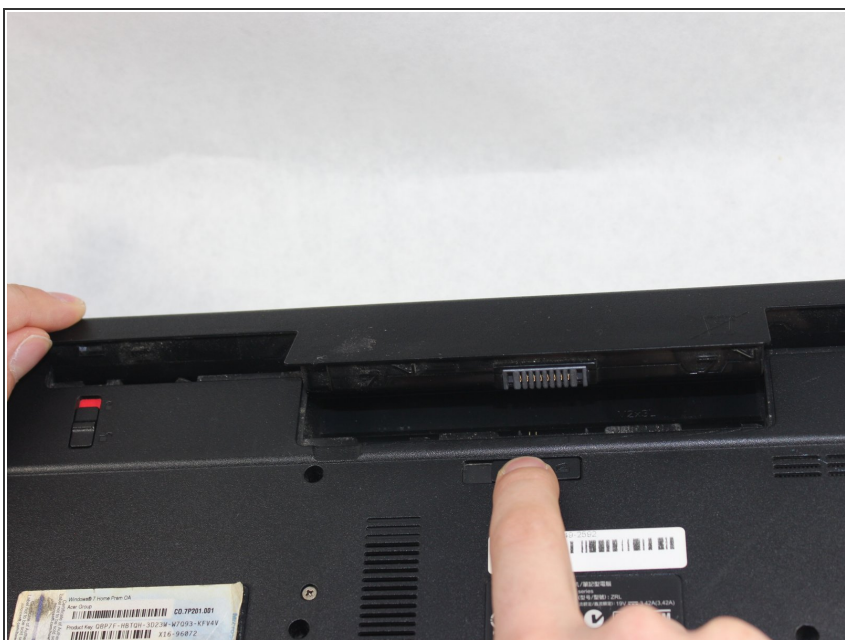
- Push the laptop battery release lock.

Step 3



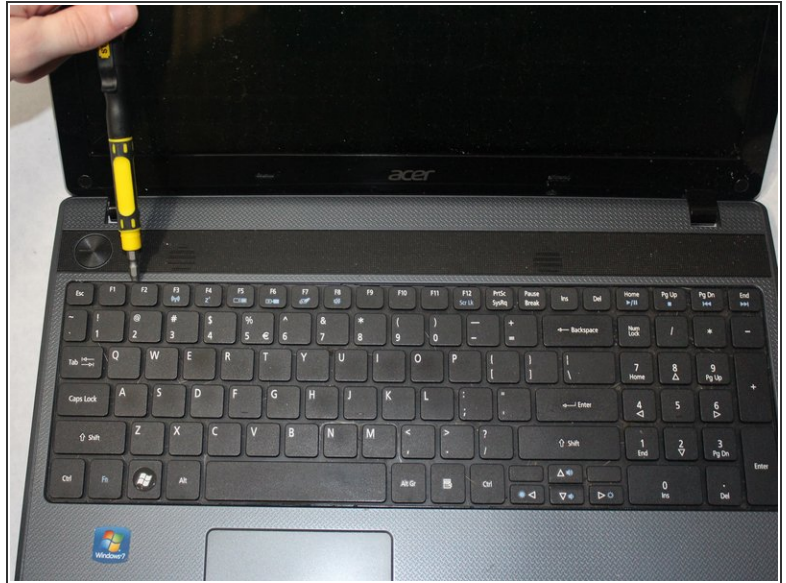
- Now that the Acer-Aspire 5349-2592 laptop battery is unlocked, press the battery release button down.

Step 4



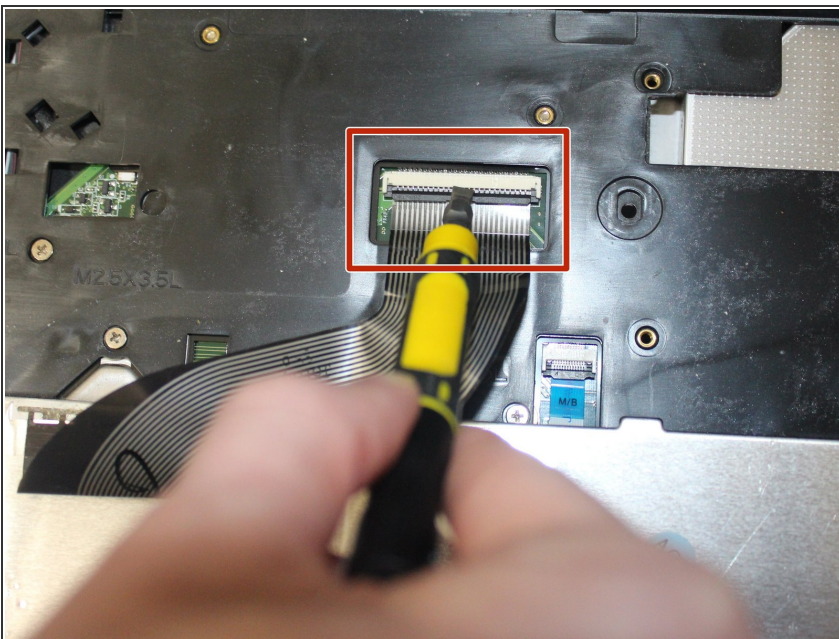
- Holding down the laptop battery release button, gently pull the battery away from the laptop.

Step 5 — Keyboard



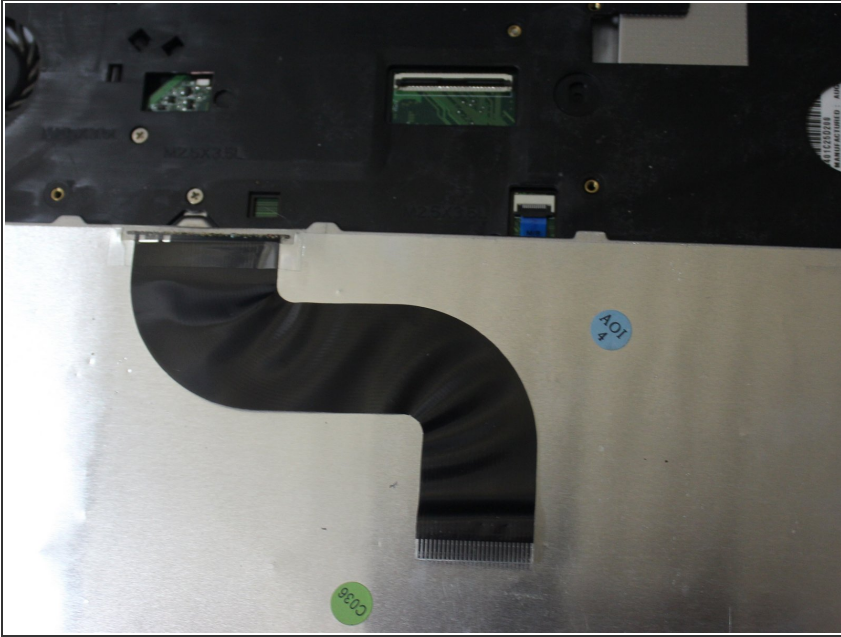
- Open the laptop and locate the top edge of the keyboard.
- Use a flathead screwdriver to gently pry the keyboard upward and lift it out of the laptop.

Step 6



- Use a flathead screwdriver to gently lift the clamp upward and remove the cable.

Step 7



- The keyboard is now disconnected and can be safely removed.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
