




# Acer Aspire E1-572G Keyboard Replacement

### TOOLS:


- Essential Electronics Toolkit (1)

## Step 1 — Keyboard




- Press and slide battery-lock button to remove the battery.

## Step 2



- Remove 17x Philips screws

## Step 3



- Remove the plastic cover
- Remove 2x Philips screws


## Step 4



- Start opening the top starting at the side of the screen


**⚠** Use plastic tools to avoid damaging the cover.

## Step 5




- Disconnect 3x flex cables

## Step 6




- Remove 6x Philips screws
- The 2 Philips screws at the top are different from the other 4 (thicker)
- Remove 3x small (silver) Philips screws

## Step 7



- Remove the metal plate by sliding it up and then flipping it over
- ⚠ Be careful to not damage the flex cable attached to the metal plate.

## Step 8



- Disconnect 2x aluminium grounding
- Lift the keyboard out

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
