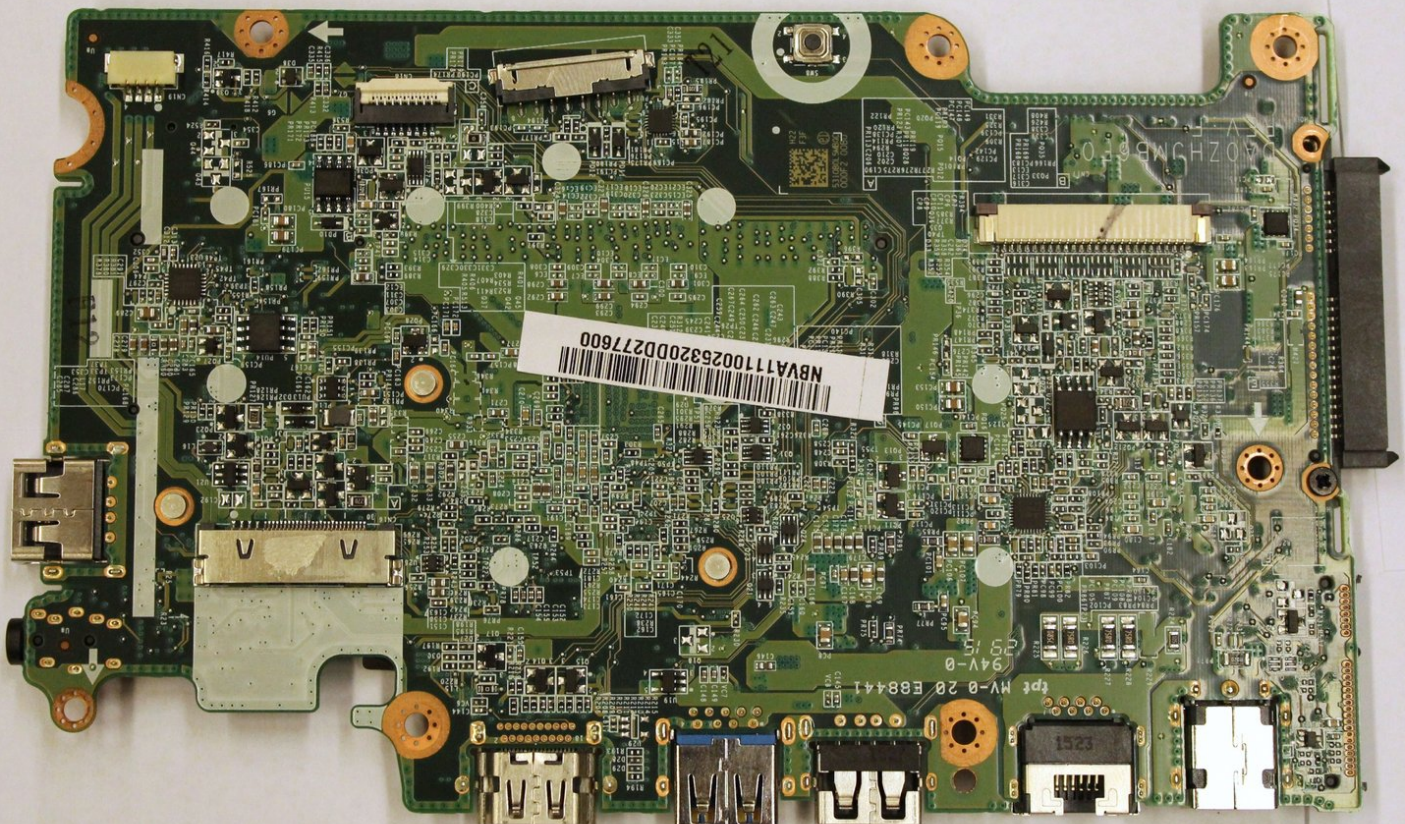




# Acer TravelMate TMB115-M-C99B Motherboard Replacement

# INTRODUCTION

If your laptop is experiencing internal communication issues, use this guide to remove and replace your motherboard.

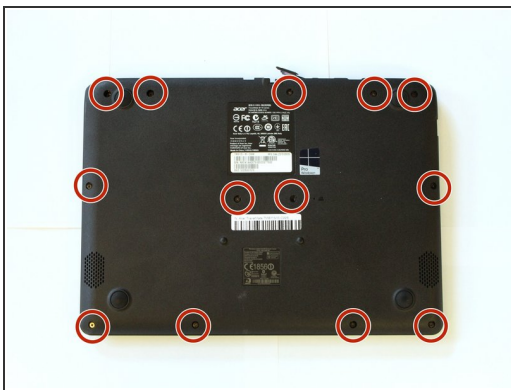
## Step 1 — Battery



 Turn off your laptop before starting.

- Flip the laptop over so the model stickers face the ceiling.

## Step 2



- Remove the thirteen 6mm Phillips screws using the #0 screwdriver.
- Remove the back of the laptop.

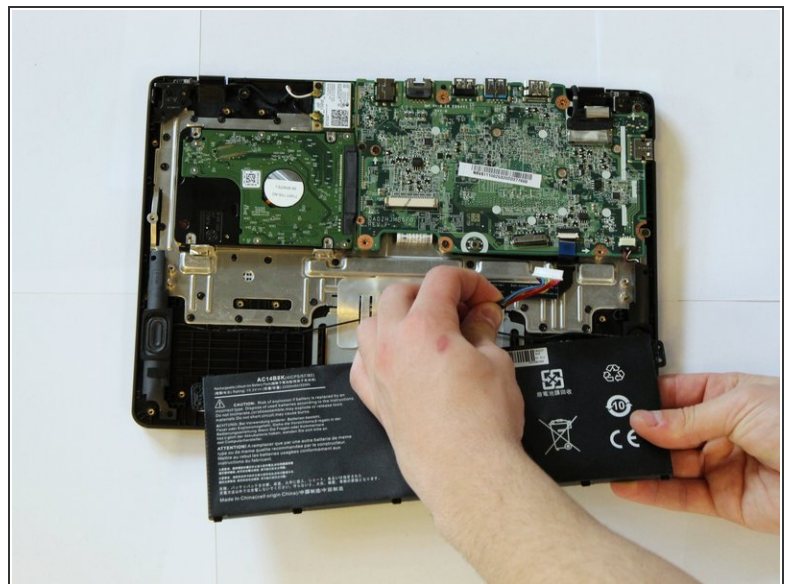
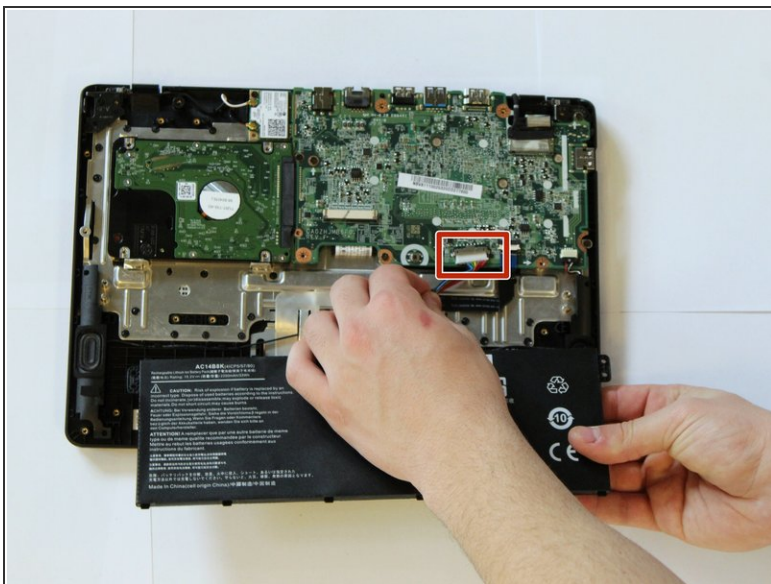


## Step 3



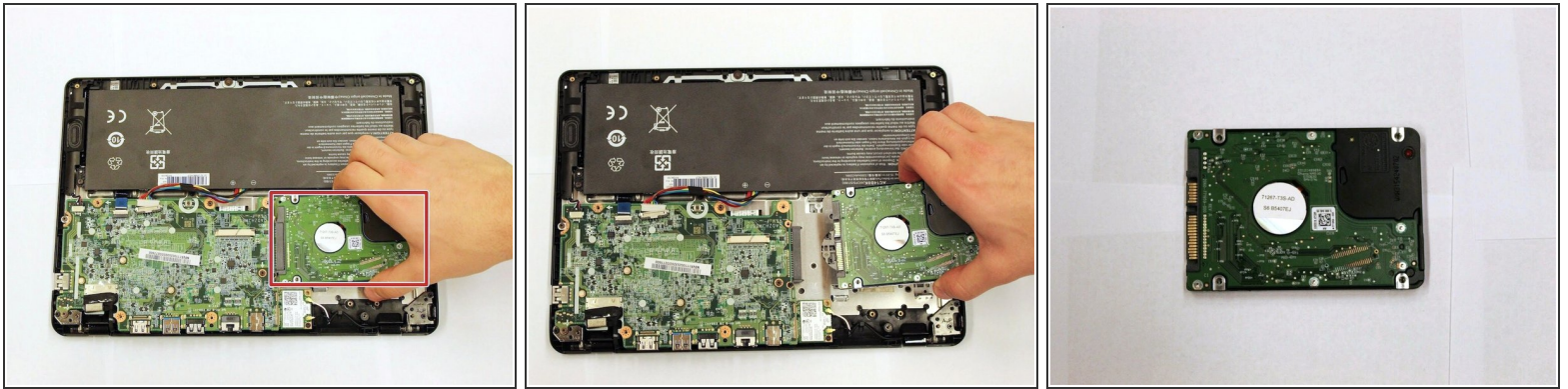
- Remove the two 7mm Phillips screws from the battery using the #0 screwdriver.

## Step 4



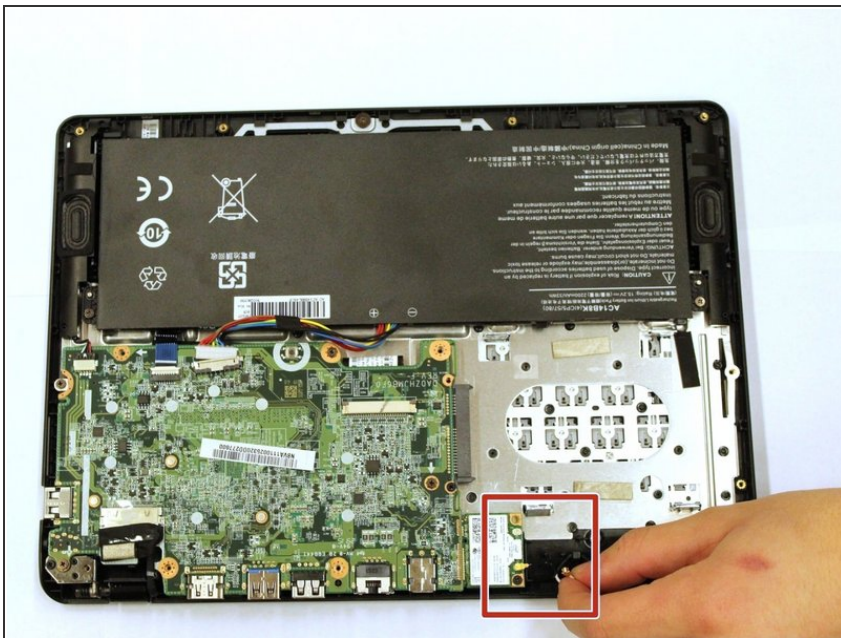
- Unplug the battery from the motherboard.

## Step 5 — Hard Drive



- Carefully disconnect the hard drive from the motherboard.

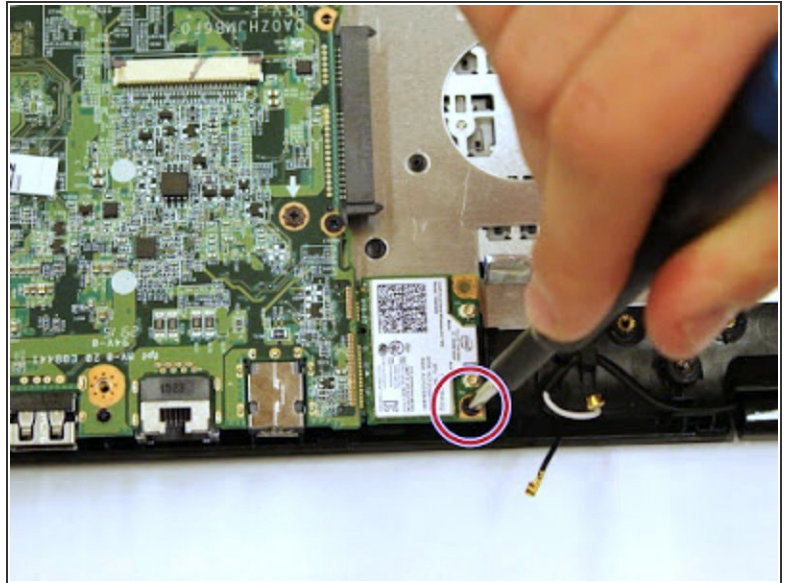
## Step 6 — Motherboard



- Disconnect the two wires from the Wi-Fi interface.

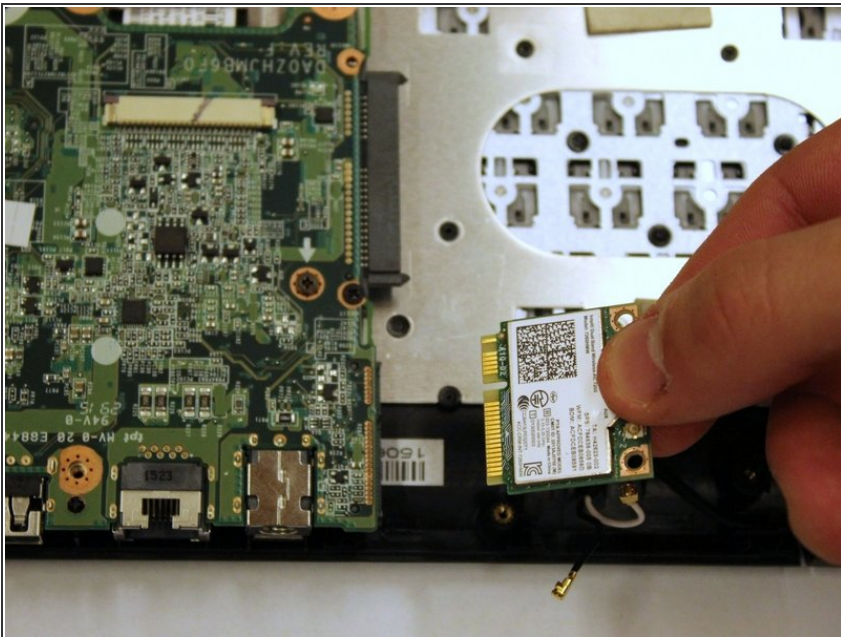


## Step 7



- Remove one 6mm Phillips screw from the Wi-Fi interface using the #0 screwdriver.

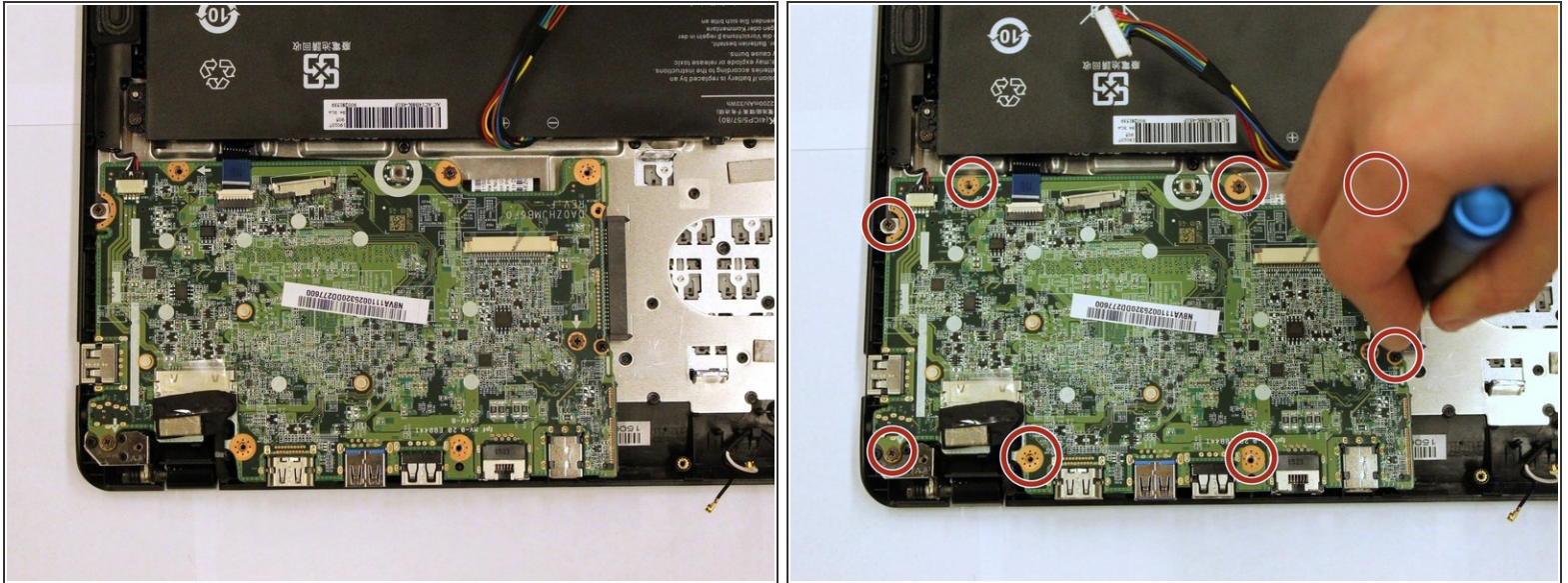
## Step 8



- Remove the Wi-Fi interface from the motherboard.

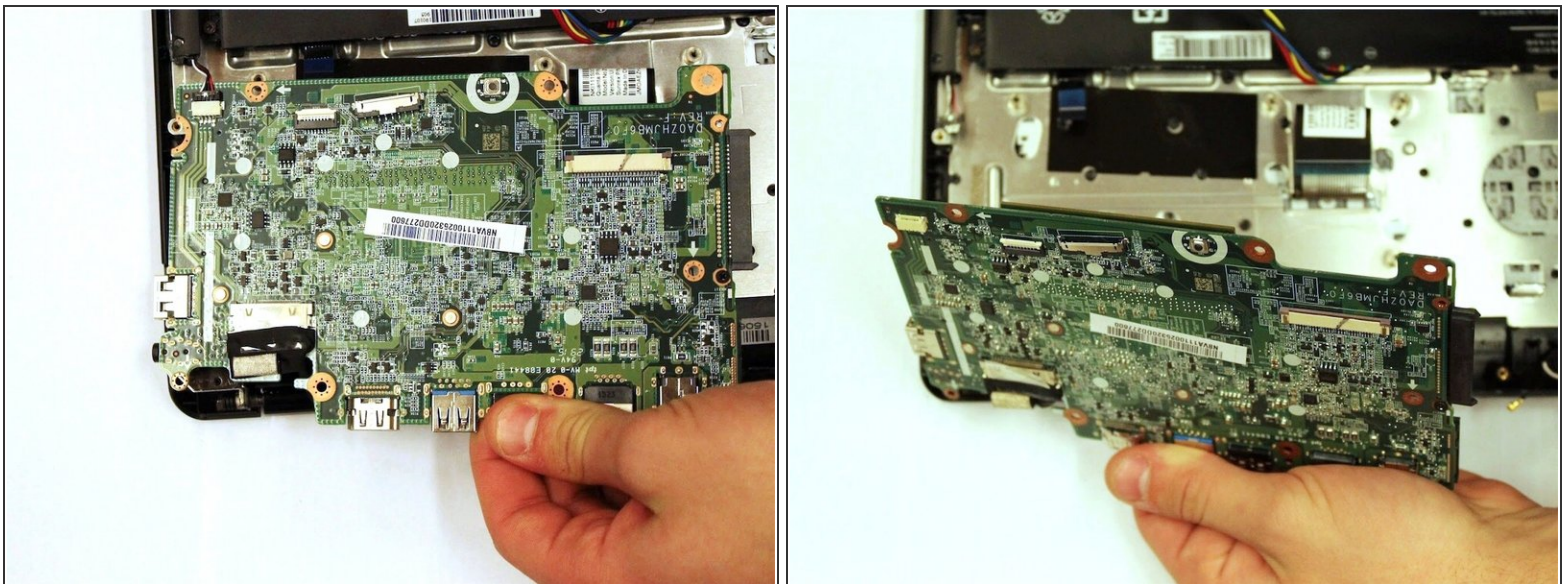


## Step 9



- Remove the eight 7mm Phillips screws from the motherboard using the #0 screwdriver.

## Step 10



- Remove the motherboard.
