INTRODUCTION

The Astro A20 microphone replacement guide shows the steps of replacing a microphone with the use of a 60 mm extension, Phillips #1 screwdriver, and a new microphone.



TOOLS:

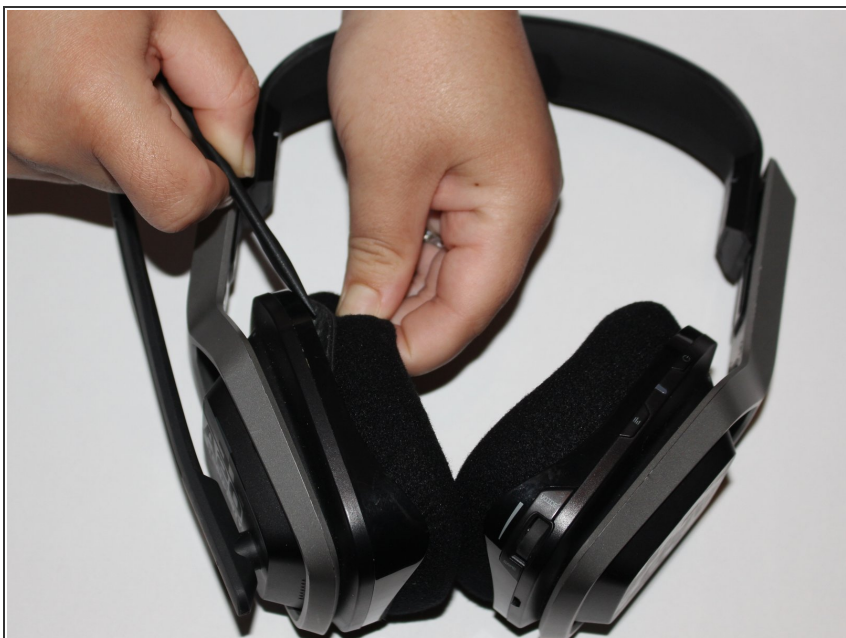
- [Spudger](#) (1)
 - [Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)
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Step 1 — Cushion



- Place one hand on the hard side of the headset ear portion and on the cushion.
- Lift the small portion on the edge of the cushion.

Step 2



- Slide the metal spudger underneath the lift part of the ear cushion.
- Pull the ear cushion while wedging the spudger around the edge of the ear cushion.

Step 3



- Remove the ear cushion from the headset.

Step 4 — Microphone



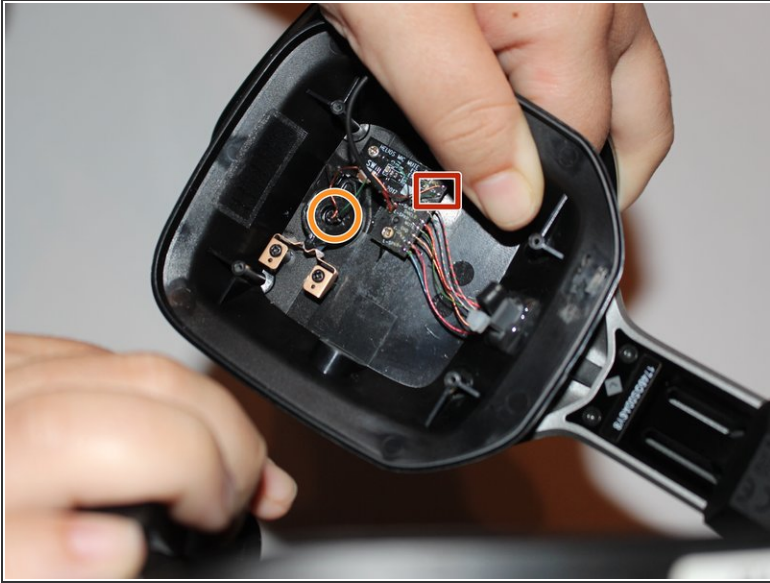
- Place one hand on the back of the speaker.

Step 5



- Remove the four 7mm screws with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.
- ⓘ You may want to use a 60mm screwdriver extension to reach the screws inside of the headset.

Step 6



- Lift the speaker area.
- Disconnect the wires that connect the microphone shown by the blue square.
- Remove the 7mm screw with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
