INTRODUCTION

Buttons can get sticky or become unresponsive. This guide will show you how to remove them for cleaning or replacing them.

Step 1 — Headset Speakers



- Remove the magnetic ear pads by gently pulling up away from the head set.

Step 2



- Squeeze the plastic opening tool between the black plastic and foam pad and then pry upwards to remove the felt pads covering the speaker.

Step 3



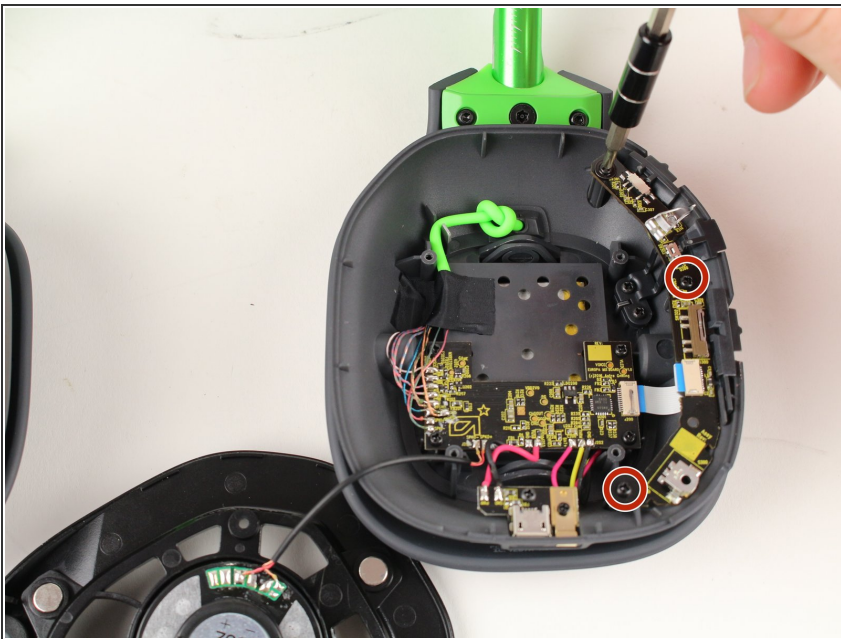
- Remove the four 6mm Phillips 1 screws.

Step 4



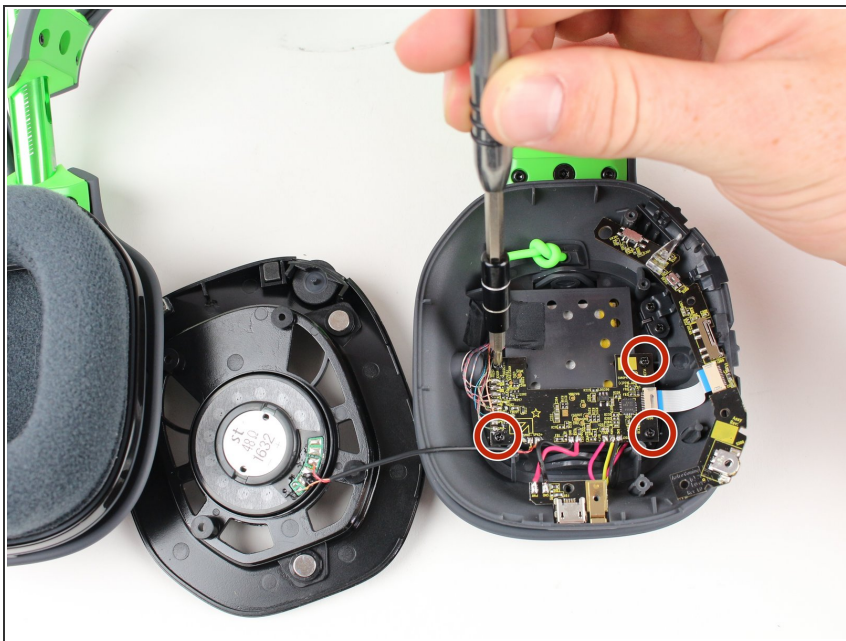
- Lift the speaker module up off the device.

Step 5 — Headset Buttons



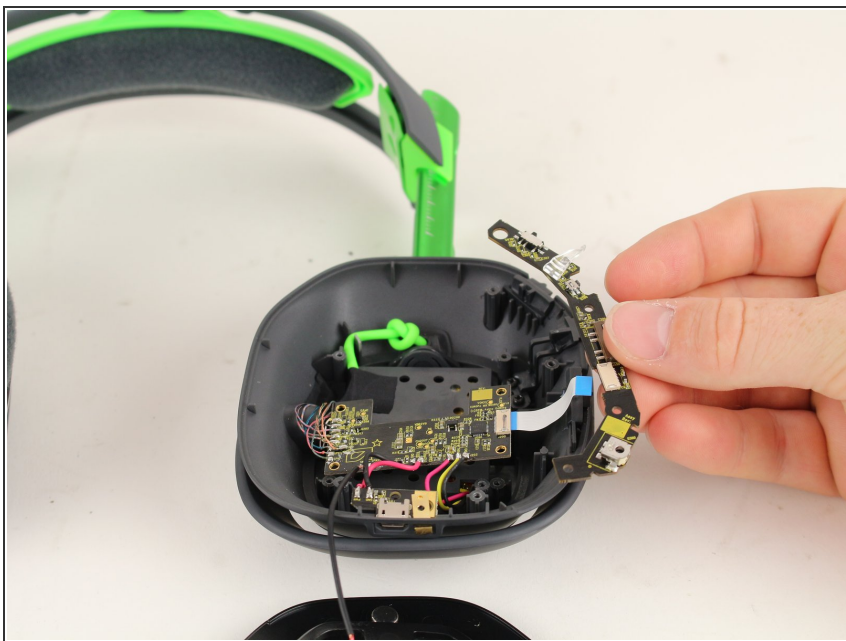
- Remove the three 6mm PH1 screws.

Step 6



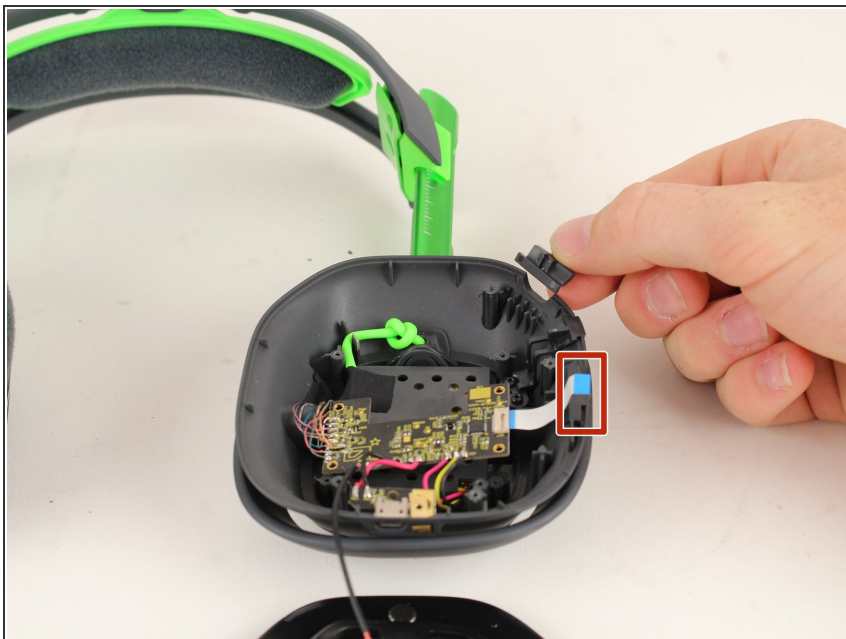
- Remove the four 6 mm PH1 screws.

Step 7



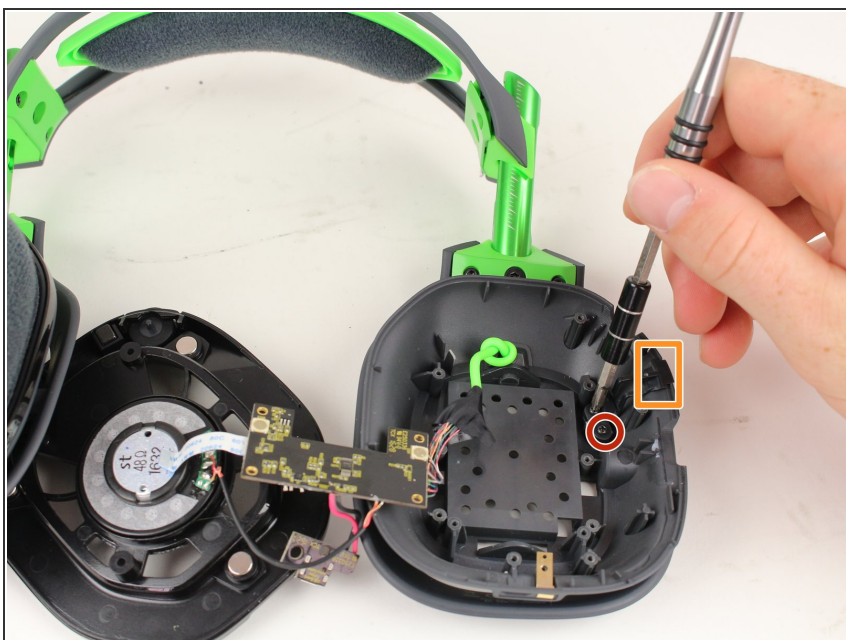
- Dettach the thin circuit board from the ribbon with your hand by pulling the board and wire in different directions.

Step 8



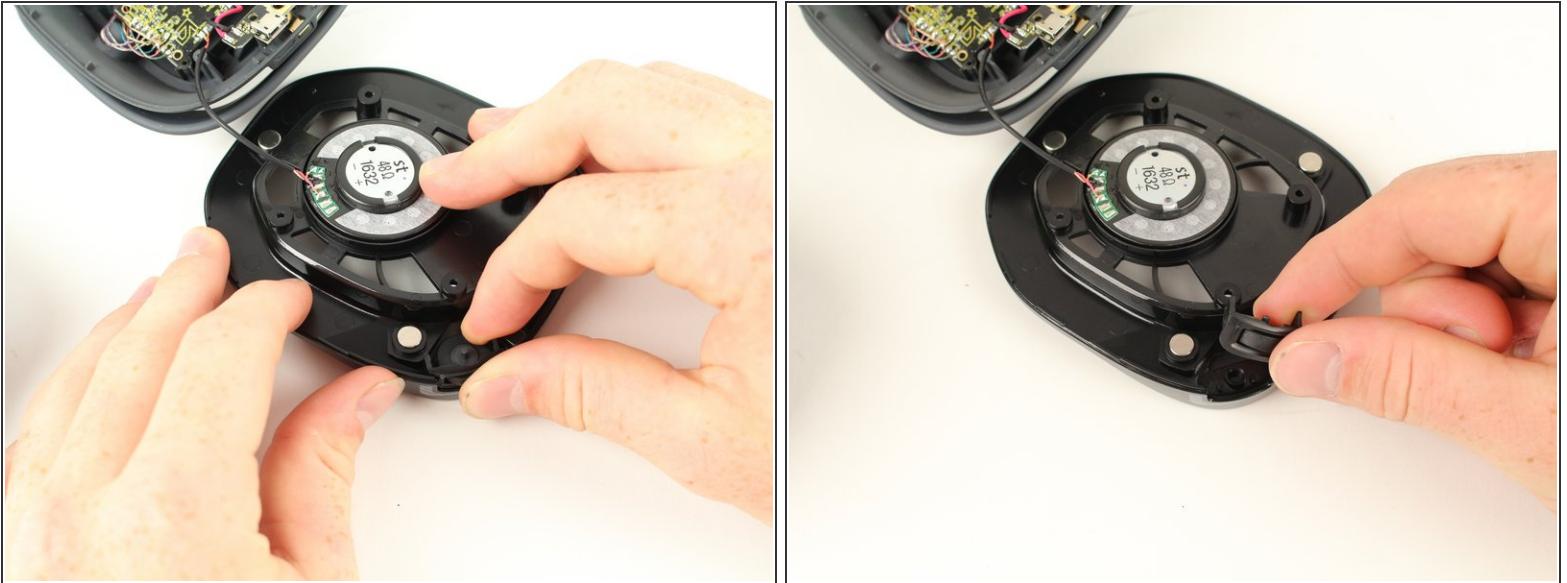
- Pull the two unscrewed buttons away from the ear cuffs with your hand.

Step 9



- Remove the two 6mm PH1 screws.
- Pull the unscrewed button away from the ear cuffs with your hand.

Step 10



- Use your hands to pull the volume wheel up and away from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
