INTRODUCTION

If your keyboard is not working this guide will be very useful. There is not much that can go wrong with this but as always be wary when unplugging wires as to avoid tearing.

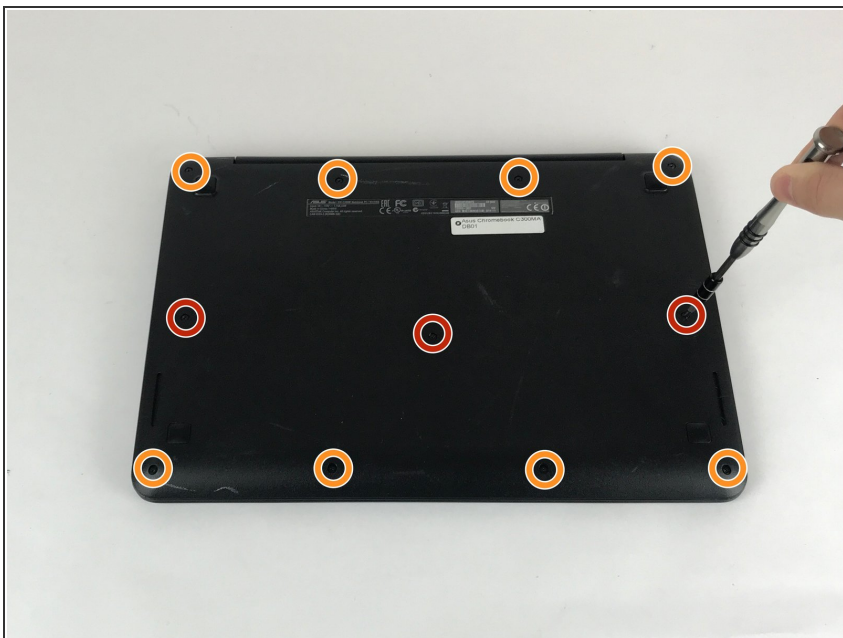

Step 1 — Back Cover



- Place device bottom-side up.

Step 2



- Remove the eight 9.0 mm Philips screws along the perimeter of the case.
- Remove the three 6.0 mm Philips screws from the center of the case.

Step 3



- Using a plastic opening tool, separate the bottom case at the seam.

Step 4



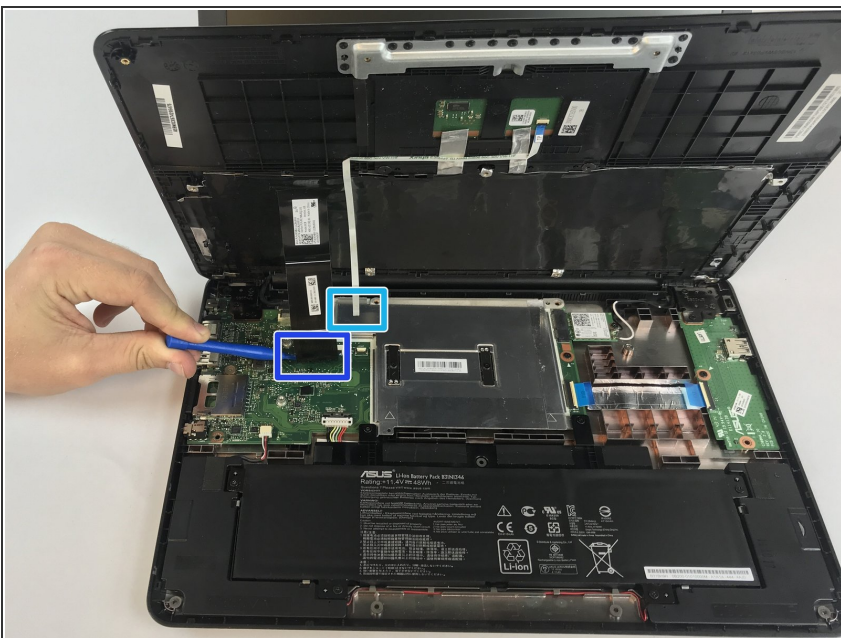
- Open the Chromebook at hinges.

Step 5 — Keyboard



- Use plastic opening tool to pry open clip holding keyboard wires to the circuitboard.

Step 6



- Use plastic opening tool to pry open clip holding mouse pad wires to the circuit board.
- Use plastic opening tool to pry open clip holding keyboard flat black wire
- Use plastic opening tool to pry open clip holding keyboard thinner white wire

Step 7



- Lift and remove keyboard from device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
