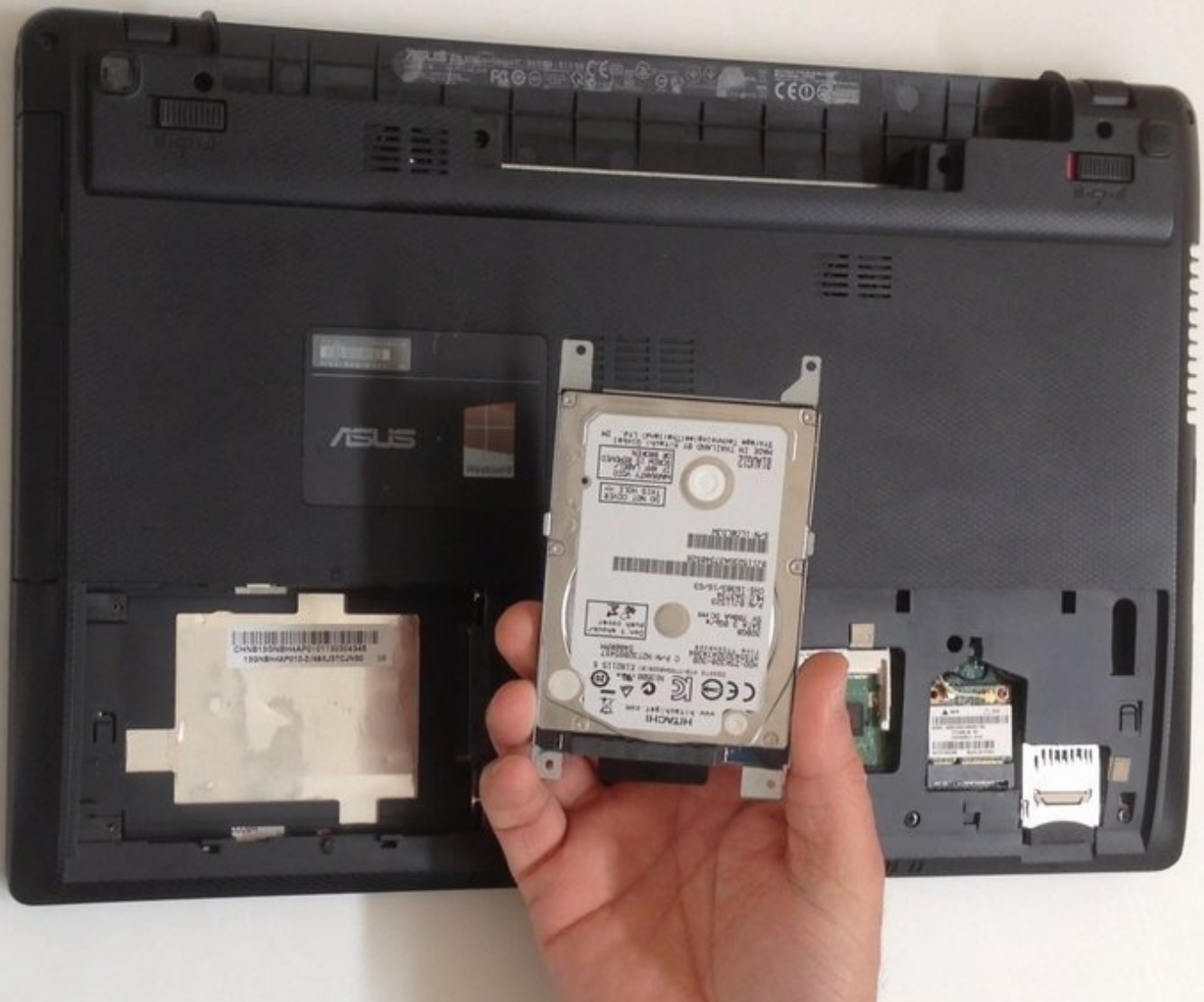

PARTS:

- [500 GB 5400 RPM 2.5" Hard Drive](#) (1)
- [1 TB 5400 RPM Samsung SATA Hard Drive \(New\)](#) (1)

Step 1 — HDD (Hard Disk Drive)



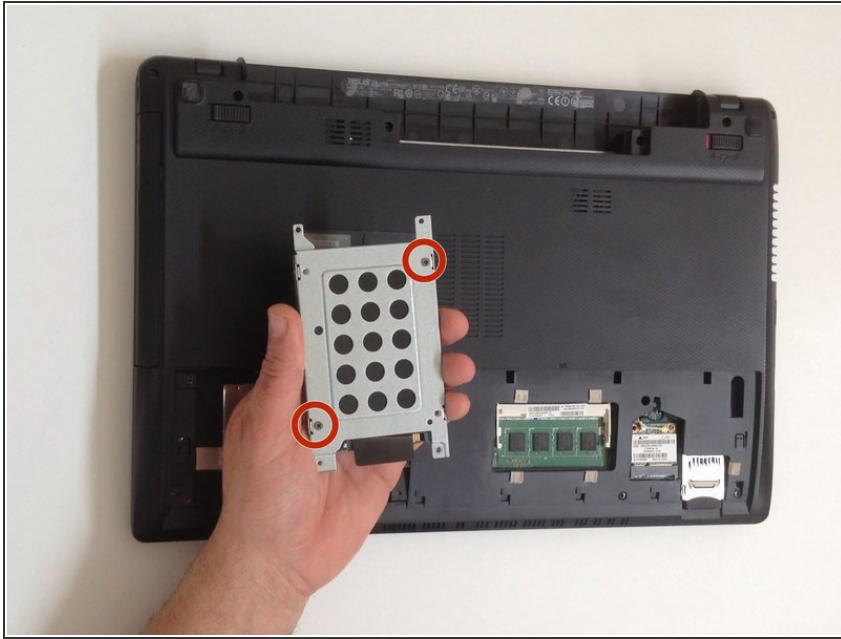
- Switch off the Laptop and remove the Battery.
- Unscrew the two Philips screws and remove the HDD / RAM Cover.

Step 2



- Remove three screws securing the hard drive caddy (hard drive assembly).
- Slide the hard drive assembly to the left to disconnect it from the motherboard.

Step 3



- Remove the two Philips screws and separate the HDD from the caddy case.
- You can install 2.5" SATA HDD, 5400rpm / 7200rpm, 320GB / 500GB / 750GB /1TB.
- ❗ After changing / upgrading the HDD you must install an operating system or clone & copy the information from the old HDD to the new one.
