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## INTRODUCTION

How to disassemble the Atari 2600 Junior to remove the circuit board.

### TOOLS:


- 3/16" Phillips Head Screwdriver (1)
- Heavy-Duty Spudger (1)

## Step 1 — Remove the base




- Remove 5 Phillips screws from base.

## Step 2 — Detach the Case





- Use a metal or heavy duty spudger to unhook the 3 plastic clips holding the front of the case together.
- Be careful not to break the plastic clips
- While unhooking the center hook use another spudger to run along the top and bottom casing. This helps to get the clip lose.
- Be careful not to pull the case apart quickly, there is a ribbon that is attached to the top and bottom.

## Step 3 — Detach the Ribbon



- Detach the ribbon from the circuit board by gently pulling ribbon out from clip.

## Step 4 — Remove Circuit Board from Base



- There are 2 clips holding the circuit board in place.
- Using a metal or heavy duty spudger release the clip on the left side.
- Remove the circuit board.
