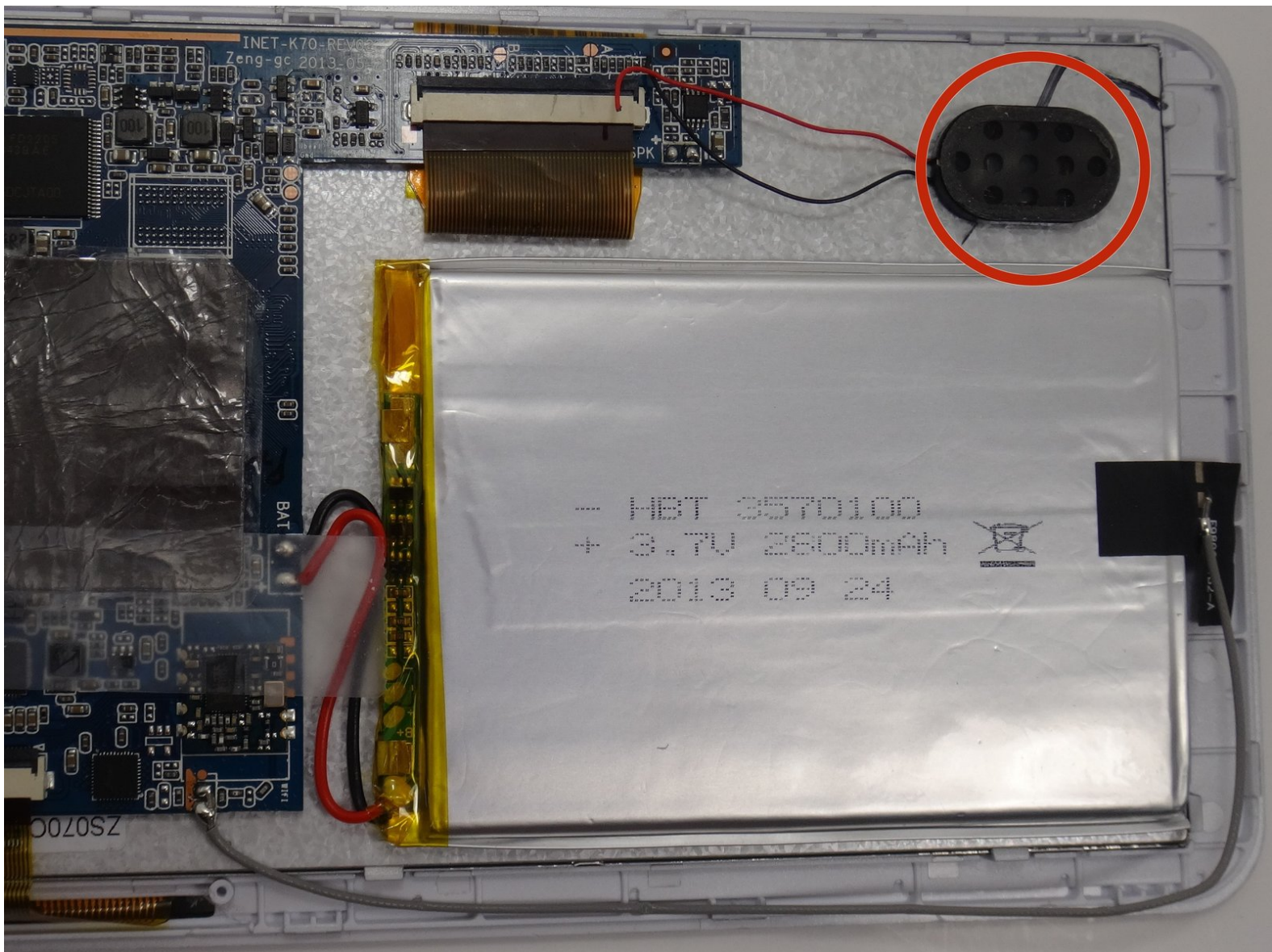




Azpen A720 Speaker Replacement

This guide will tell you how to replace the speaker in your Azpen A720 tablet.

INTRODUCTION

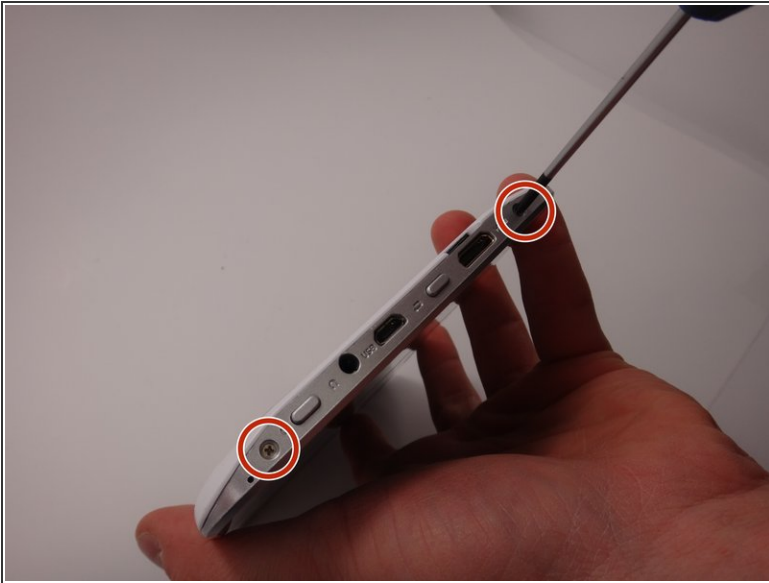
The speaker is responsible for all non-headphone sounds from your tablet. If these sounds are not audible when they should be you may need to replace the speaker. Speaker replacement is a relatively easy task and this guide will help you through it.

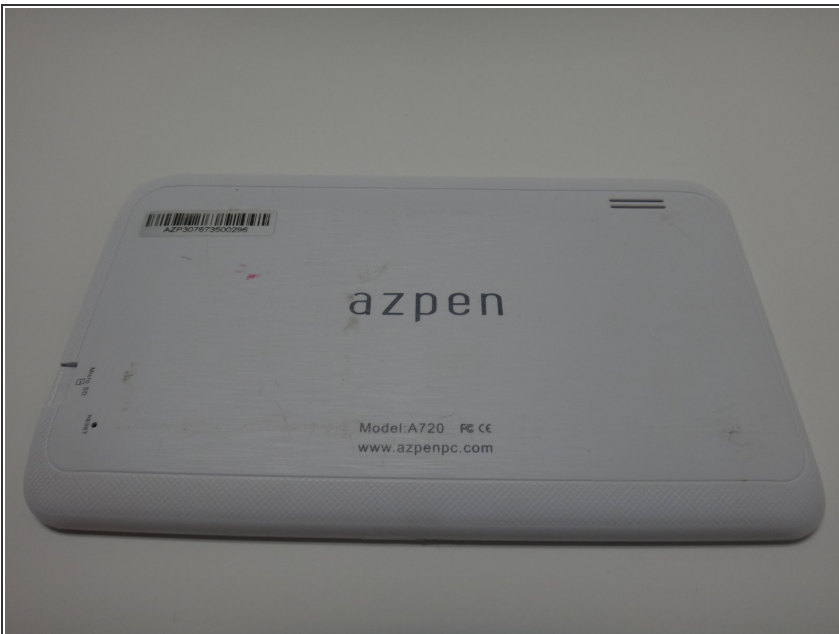
Step 1 — Aspen A720 Back Cover Replacement



- Use the Phillips # 00 screwdriver to remove the two screws found on the top edge of the tablet near the power button and mini HDMI port (4mm).

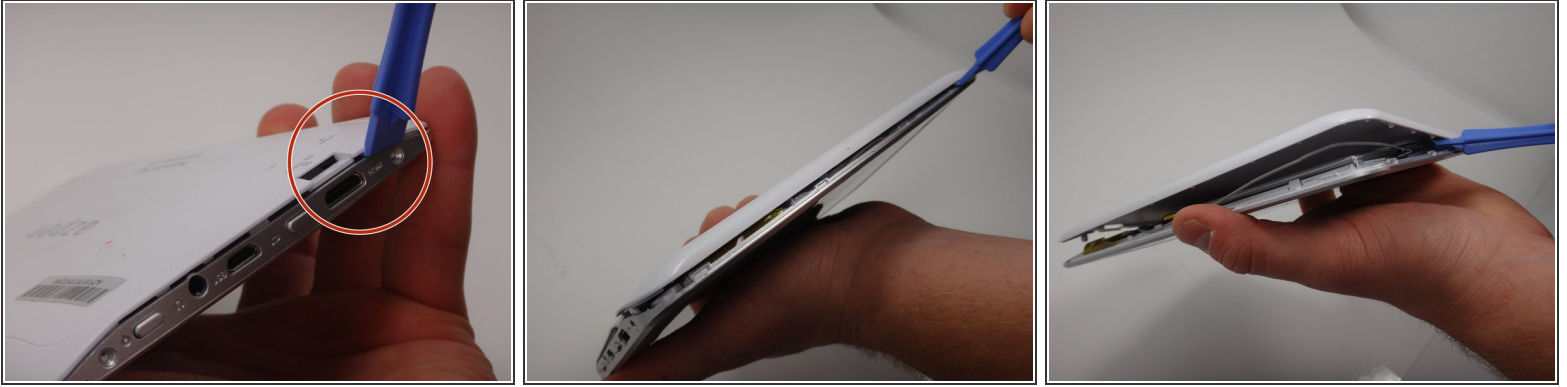
⚠ Make sure to keep track of screws.

Step 2



- Lay the tablet screen-side down.

Step 3



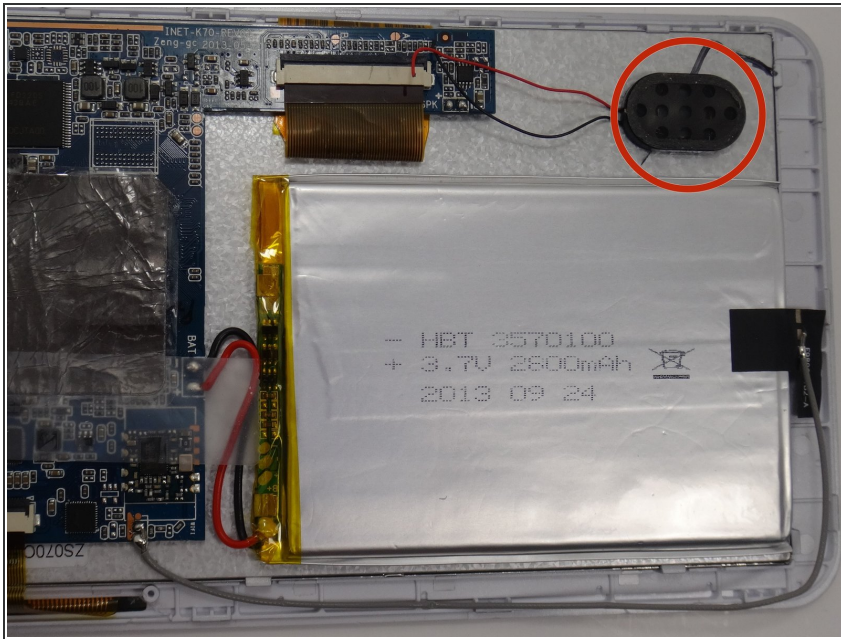
- Use the plastic opening tool to pry the white back from the silver frame. Start near the micro SD slot.
- Slide the plastic opening tool around the perimeter of the casing until the back is disconnected.

Step 4



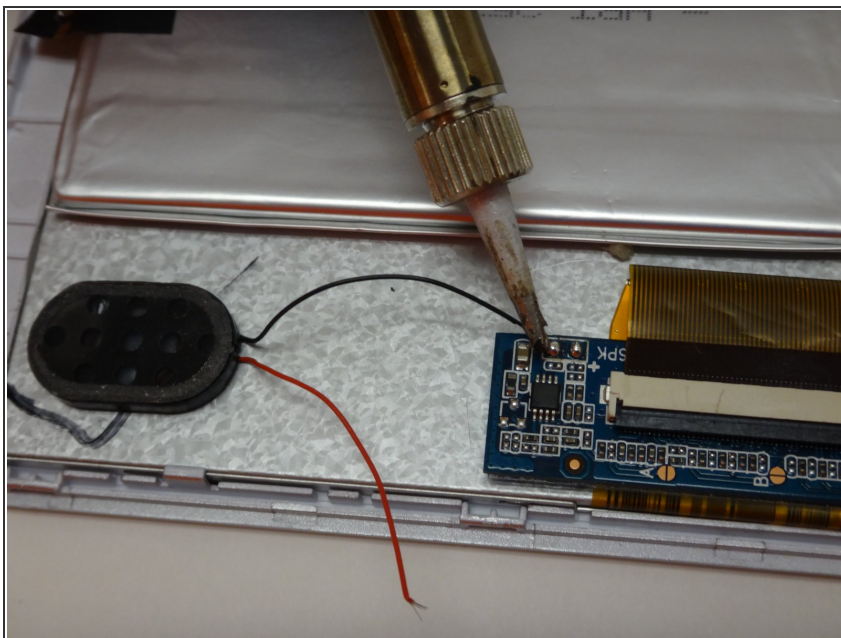
- Take the white backing off your tablet.

Step 5 — Speaker



- Locate the speaker, it is a black oval in the corner near the battery.

Step 6



- Use a soldering iron to melt the connections between the black and red speaker wires and the motherboard.
- ⚠ The soldering iron gets very hot, be careful not to touch the tip and burn yourself. To learn to solder click [here](#).

Step 7



- Remove the speaker, it is a magnet and is loosely attached to the metal backing.
- Replace the speaker with a new one.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
