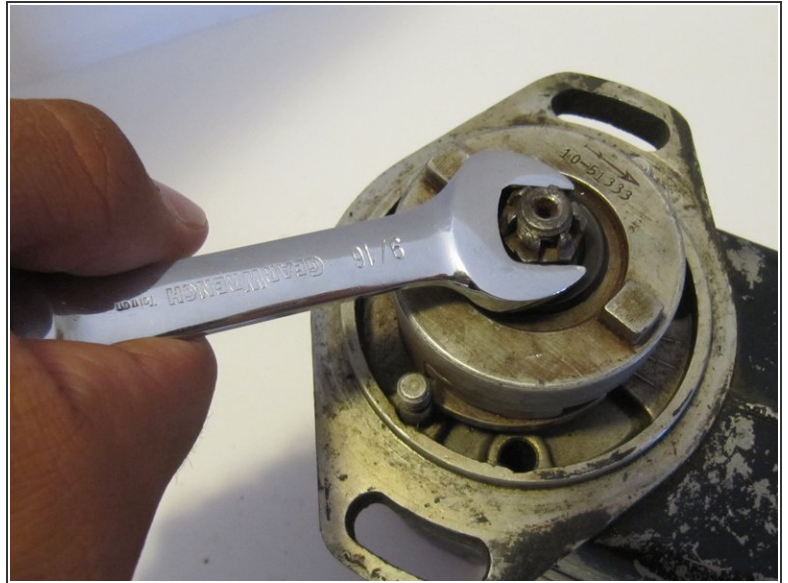
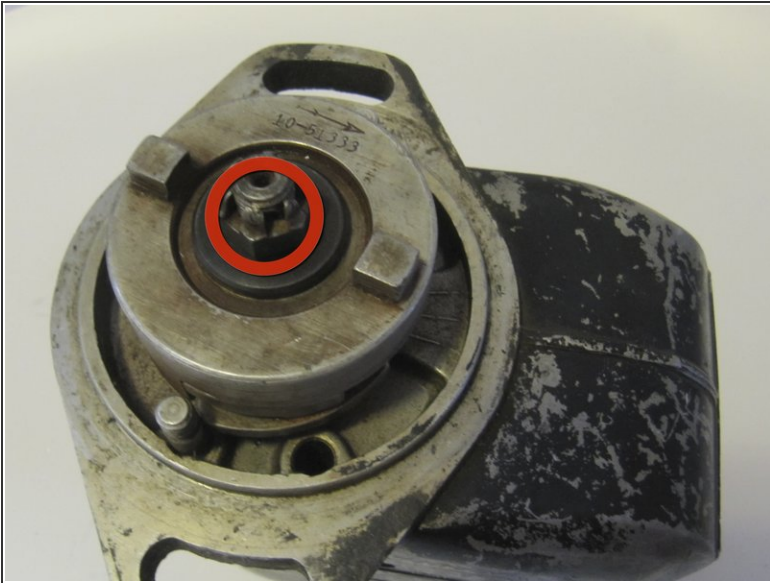
INTRODUCTION

A failed impulse coupling can cause the crankshaft gear to break off. This will cause the aircraft's magneto not to work therefore the aircraft's engine will not start.

TOOLS:

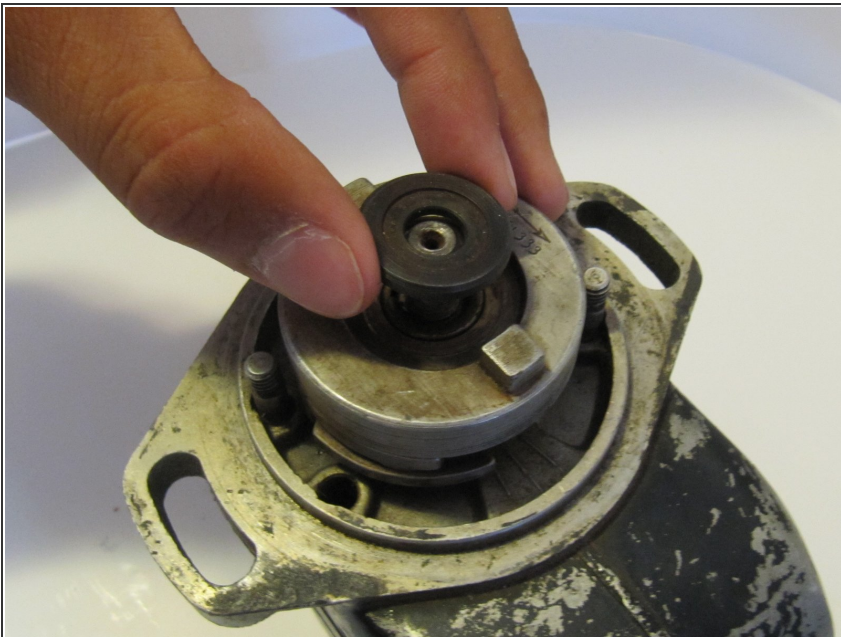
- [9 16 wrench](#) (1)

Step 1 — Impulse Coupling

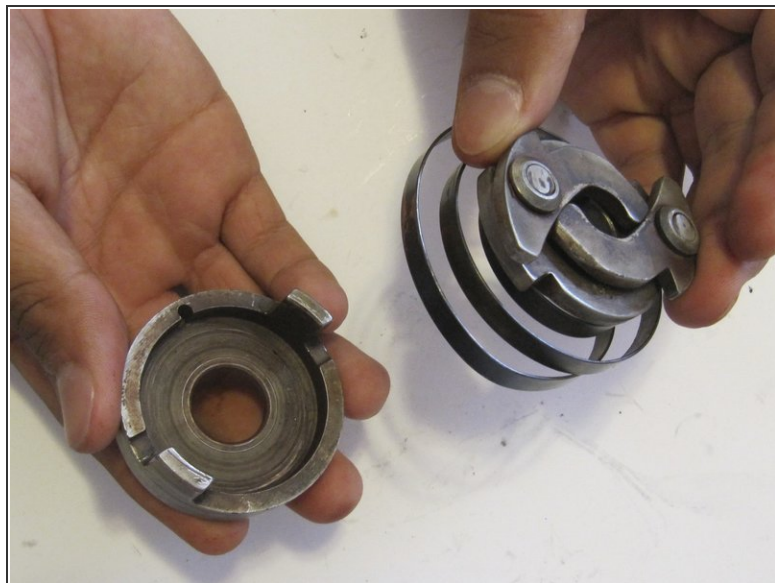
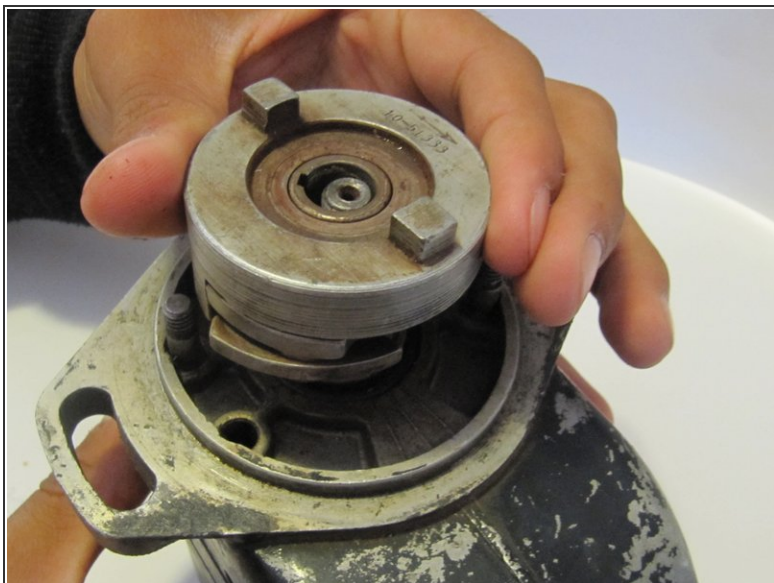


- Use a 9/16 wrench to unscrew the nut on the drive shaft.

Step 2



- Remove the lock washer underneath the nut.

Step 3

- Pull away the impulse coupling.
