



Bowling Ball Finger Inserts Replacement

How to replace your old finger inserts without having to take it somewhere to get it done.

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INTRODUCTION

In this guide, we will show you all the proper steps in [#|order] to replace your bowling ball finger inserts with newer ones. You will need a knife, super glue, new inserts, and of course the bowling ball.

TOOLS:

- Pocket knife (1)

PARTS:

- Finger grips (1)
- Super Glue (1)

Step 1 — Finger Inserts



- Set up bowling ball, facing you with finger grips up right towards the sky

Step 2




- Insert the knife in between the ball and the grip

Step 3




- Run knife around the edge of the grip, removing glue that is on the grip

Step 4




- Pull finger grip out

Step 5



- Scrap extra super glue and finger grip until all the glue is gone

Step 6



- Insert the new finger grip into the bowling ball

Step 7



- Push down on the grip until it is level on the bowling ball.

Step 8



- Peel back the grip with your finger, apply a small drop of super glue within the gap of the finger grip and bowling ball.

Step 9



- Apply pressure of the new finger grip, hold for 10 seconds, allowing the super glue to dry.

Step 10



- New finger grip is now installed! Now repeat all the previous steps to replace the other finger grip.

Enjoy your new, nice colorful grips in your bowling ball!!!
