




# Chromebook 14-x015wm Key Replacement


## INTRODUCTION

### TOOLS:


- Flathead Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Key



- Take a flathead screw driver and place it right under the key. Very gently pry it up. If it doesn't come off right away, try and loosen it by using the flathead on all four sides and wiggle it.

## Step 2



- Once the key is off, all you have to do to put a new key on is center it exactly how the original one was, and push down.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
