INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace the fuel tank on your Craftsman 9.0 HP 26 Inch Snow Blower.

Step 1 — Fuel Tank



- Remove the fuel line from the fuel tank.

Step 2



- Drain all of the fuel from the fuel tank.

Step 3



- Unscrew the tank cap and ensure that all of the fuel has been drained out.

Step 4



- Remove the four support bolts on the top of the tank and motor.

Step 5



- Lift the fuel tank off of the lower supporting brackets.

Step 6



- Replace the cracked fuel tank and place a new one onto the lower supporting brackets.

Step 7



- Screw in the top four supporting bracket bolts to hold the new fuel tank in place.

Step 8



- Reconnect the fuel line and hose clamp.

Step 9



- Fill the tank with fuel to make sure the hose clamp does not leak.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
