INTRODUCTION

Before going into replacing anything on this drill you will want to read through this guide in order to properly disassemble the drill. Following these steps will be your first step in most replacements.

TOOLS:

- [T10 Torx Screwdriver \(1\)](#)
- [H5.0 bit Driver \(2\)](#)

Step 1 — Disassembly



- Use a T-10 Torx bit screwdriver to take out the 4 screws shown.

Step 2



- Use 2 H-5.0 bit drivers to take out the main bolt and head.
- Note: there will be blue locktite on the tread

Step 3



- Pull apart 2 halves of the handle.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
