




Dell Chromebook 13-7310 Battery Replacement

This guide will take shows a step by step process of removing and replacing the battery in a Dell Chromebook 13-7310.

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INTRODUCTION


Computer batteries can sometimes become weaker over time, losing charge and making it difficult to properly use your device. If your battery is not functioning correctly anymore, then follow this guide to remove/replace the battery in a Dell Chromebook 13-7310.



TOOLS:

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Step 1 — Back Cover



- Remove the eleven 3mm Phillips #1 screws.

Step 2



- Use a plastic opening tool to gently remove the back panel.
- ⓘ It can be easier to pry open near a corner.

- Use your fingers to remove the connecting cable to the battery unit. Firmly grab the cord closest to the motherboard connection and pull straight back.
