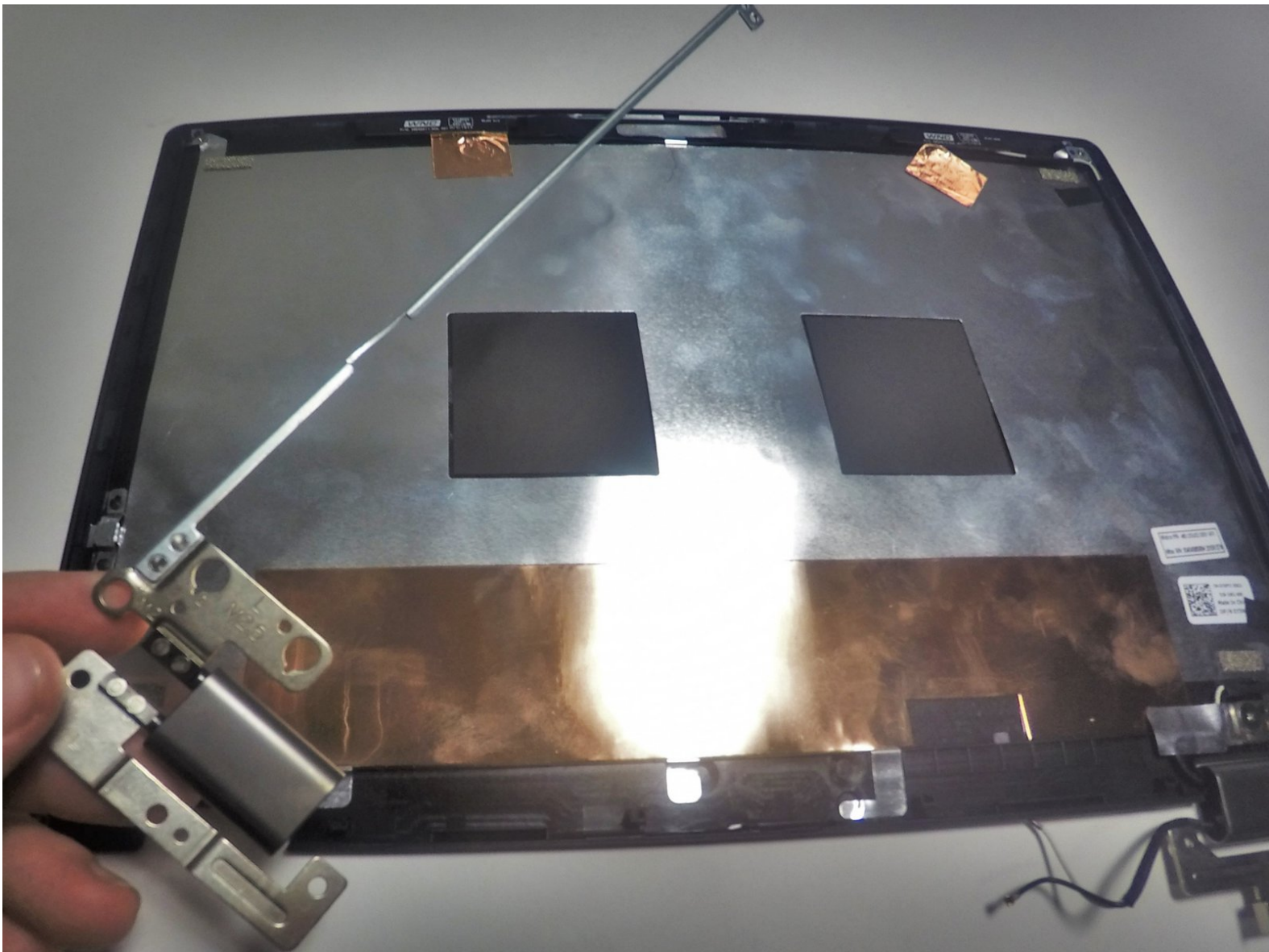




Dell Inspiron 13-7352 Hinge Replacement

This guide will show you how to replace a single hinge or both hinges if an issue occurs in your device.

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INTRODUCTION

The hinges are what control the device lid opening and closing. If the hinges on your device are worn from general wear and tear or have been broken, refer to this guide for step by step instructions on how to replace the hinges.

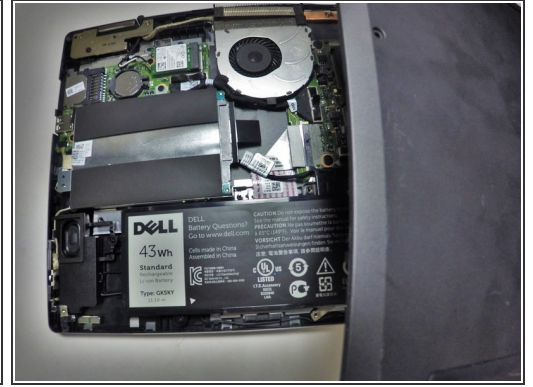

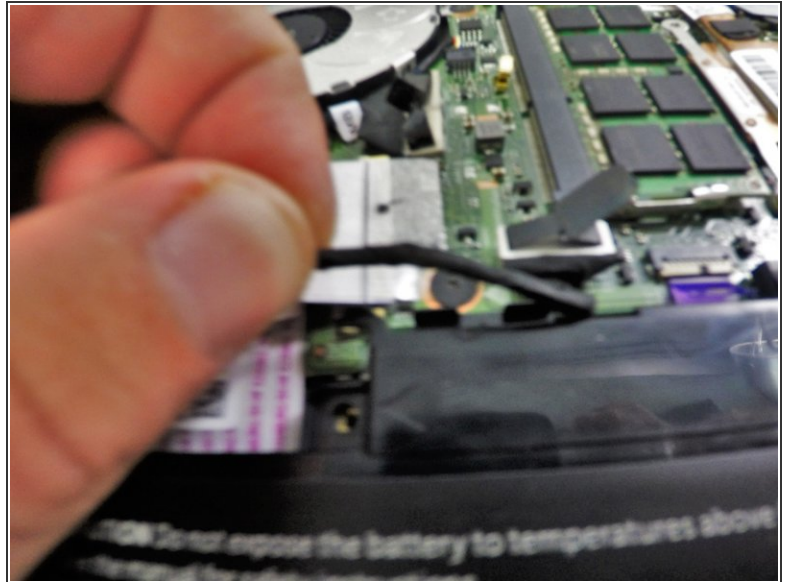
Step 1 — Battery



 Before disassembling your laptop, be sure it is powered off.

- Remove the ten 7.5mm screws that secure the back panel with the Phillips #0 head
- Use the plastic opening tool to remove the back panel.

Step 2



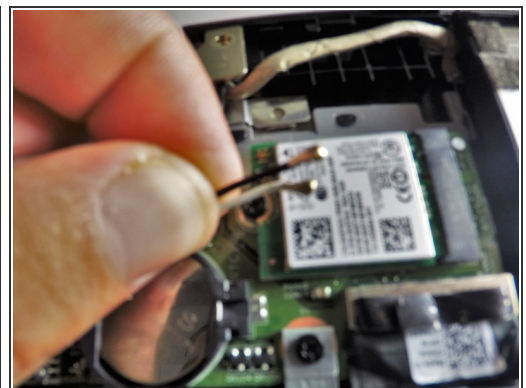
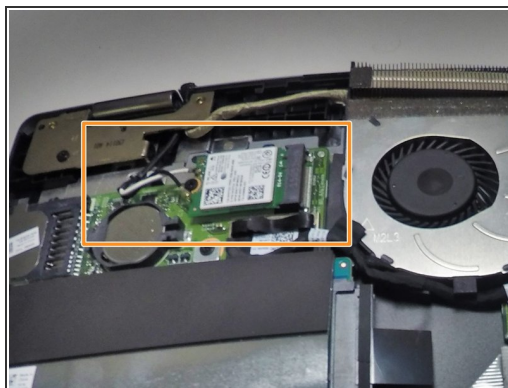
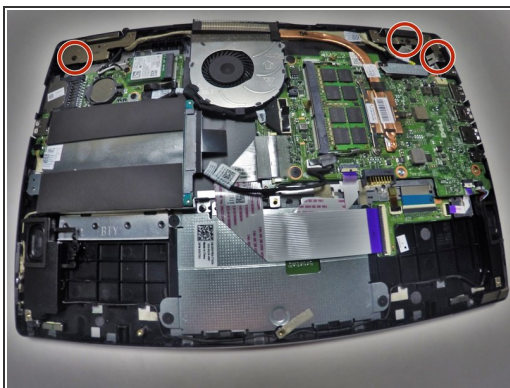
- Remove the two 3mm screws with the Phillips #0 head that hold down the battery.
- Remove the Hard Drive wire from the battery clip by detaching the wire

Step 3



- Gently remove the battery from the rest of the device.

Step 4 — Hinge



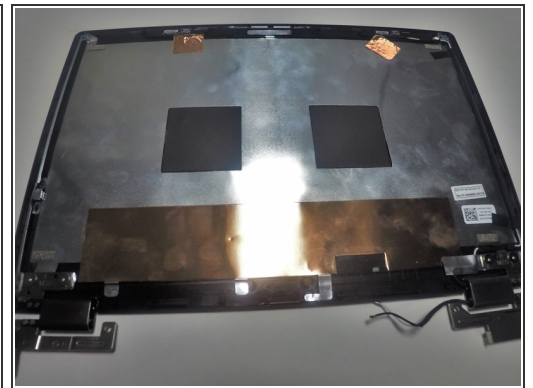
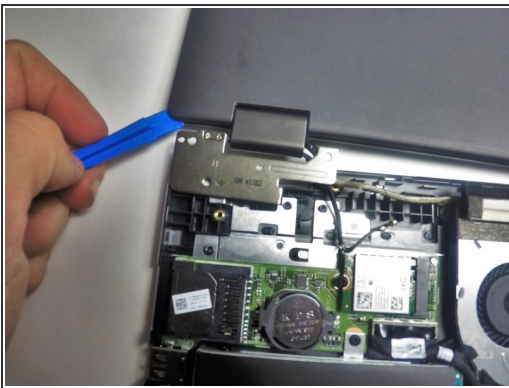
- Remove the three 8mm screws with the Phillips #0 head connected to each of the hinges.
- Take out the antenna cables from the routing guide on the hinge cover by pulling them from their original position

Step 5



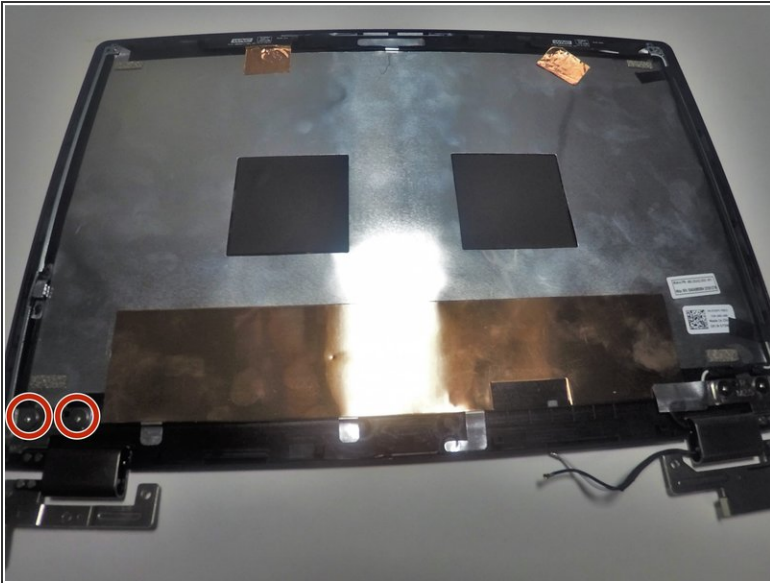
- Lay the screen flat on a smooth flat surface to release the hinges.

Step 6



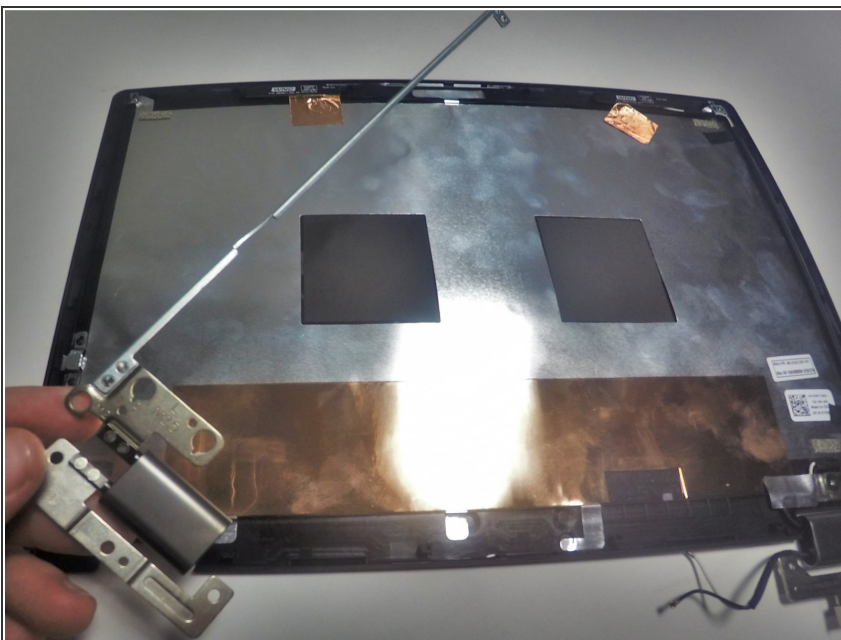
- Use the plastic opening tool around the edges of the screen to separate the screen back from the display until the backing is loose enough to pull apart with your hands.
- The second image should be the result of removing the back of the screen.

Step 7



- Locate the hinge or hinges that need to be replaced and remove the two, or four, 3mm screws with the Phillips #0 head.
- Remove the single, (or both, depending on if you are replacing one or both hinges) 6mm screw(s) from the top of the hinge with the Phillips #0 head.

Step 8



- Grasp the hinge from the edge as shown and separate the hinge from the display.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
