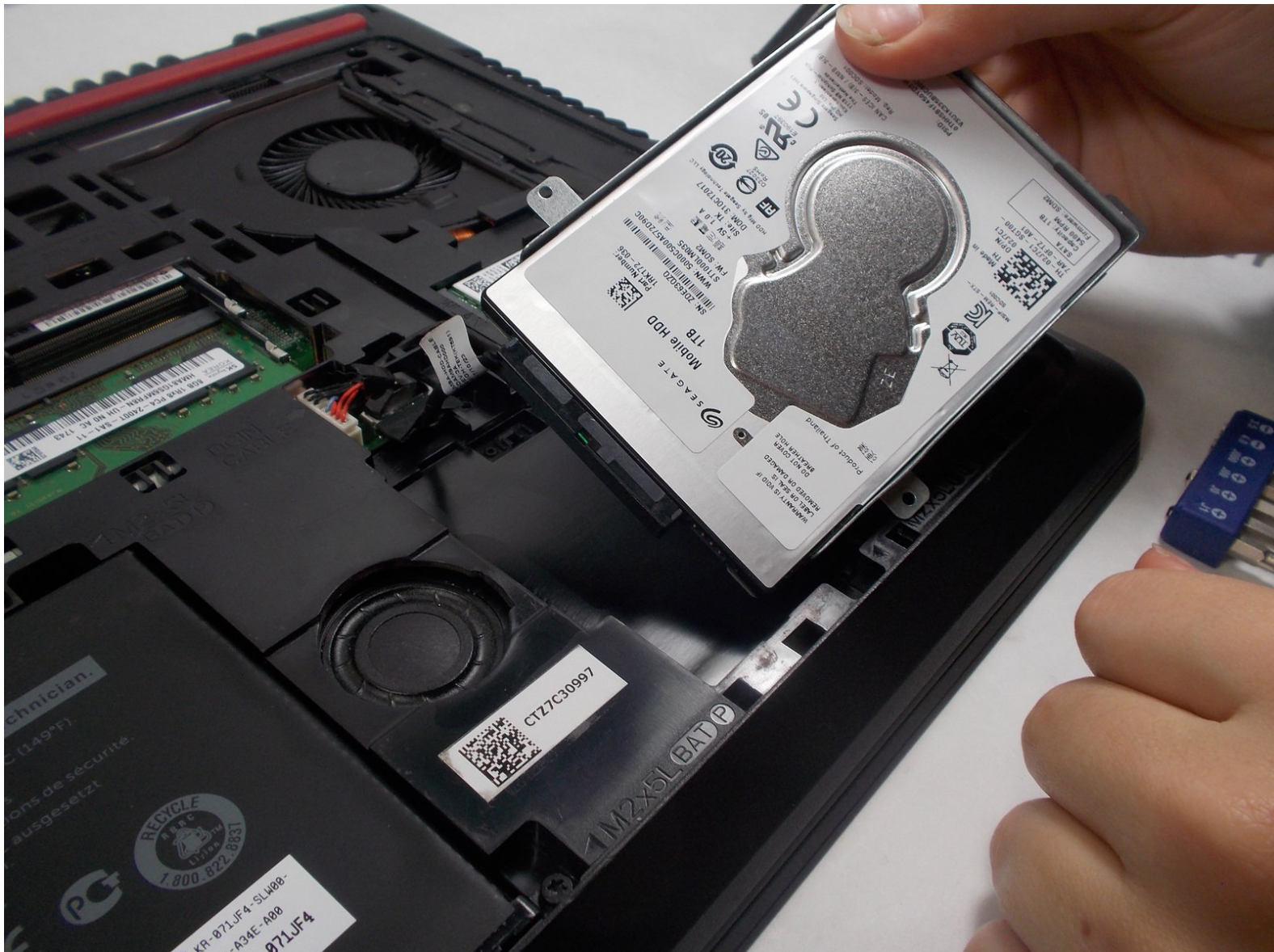




Dell Inspiron 15 5577 Gaming Hard Drive Replacement

INTRODUCTION

Step 1 — Hard Drive



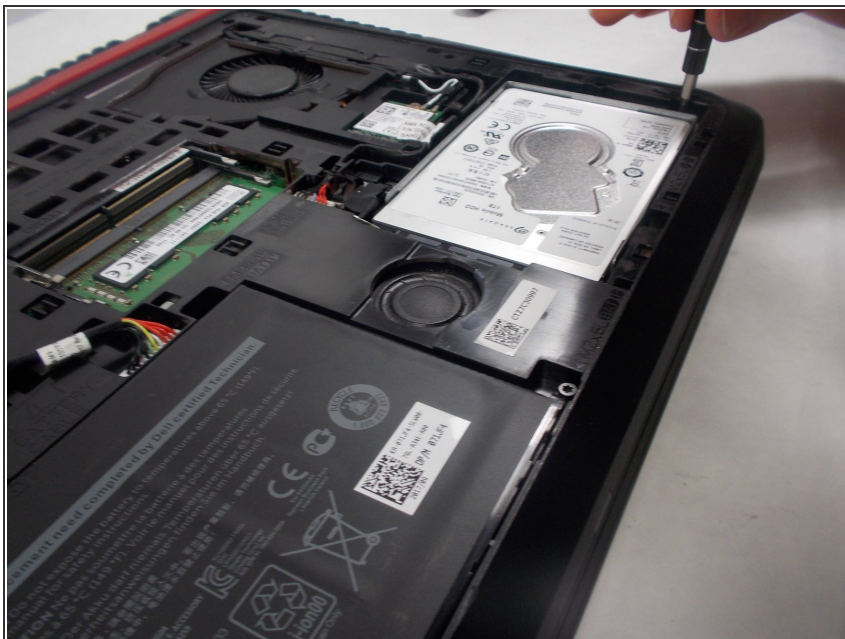
- Unscrew the back cover using a Phillips head screwdriver.

Step 2



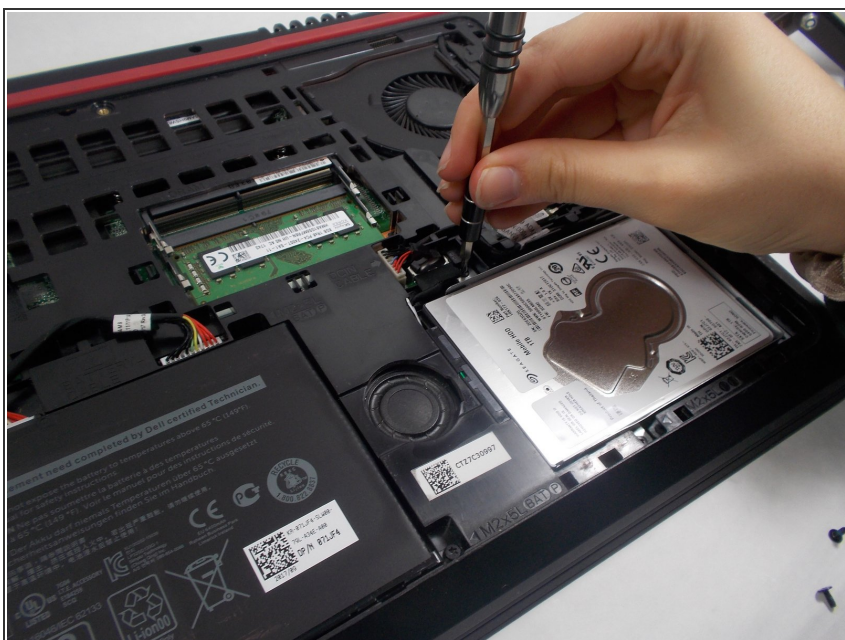
- Remove the back cover. If you're having difficulty removing it, use a plastic opening tool, and pry the back cover away from the laptop.

Step 3



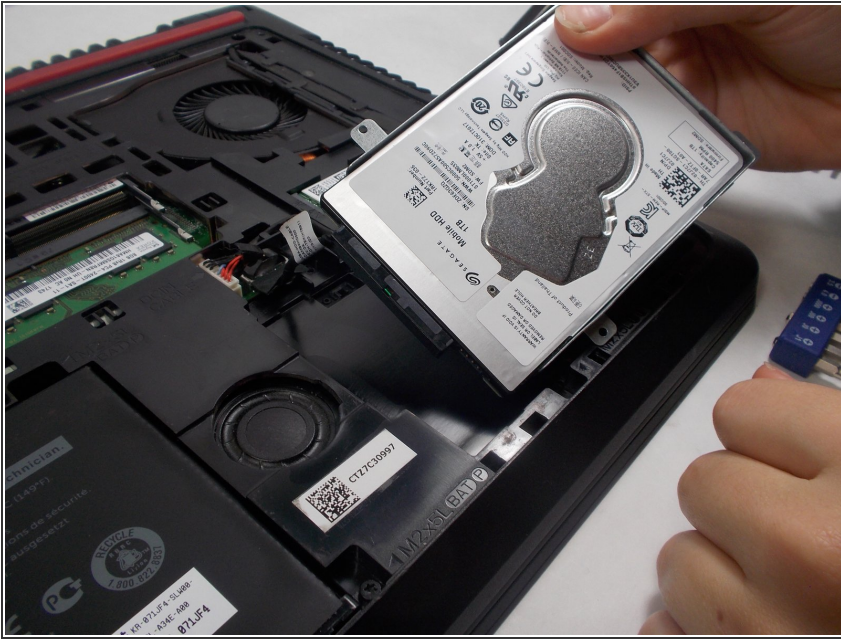
- Unscrew the screws located around the hard drive.

Step 4



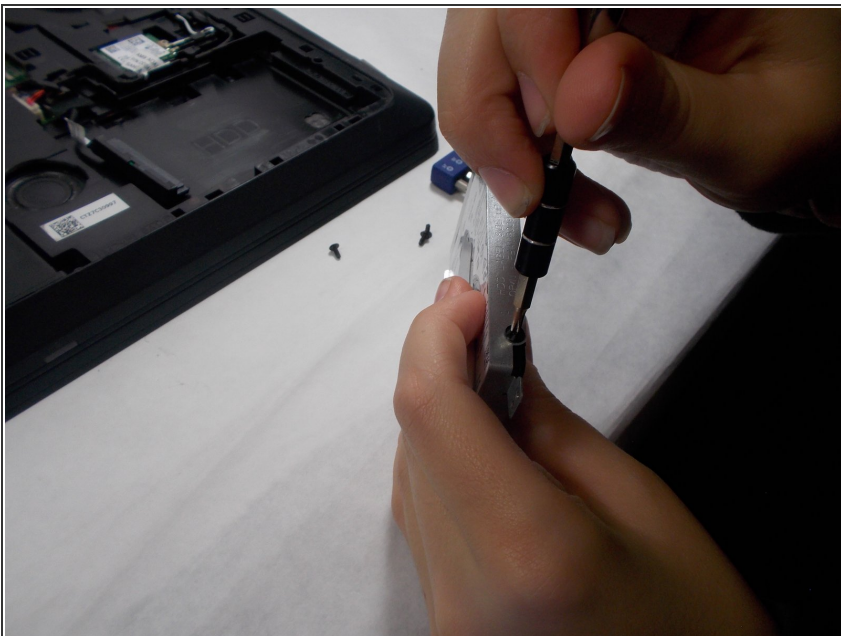
- Remove the cable above the hard drive. This can be done with a gentle tug perpendicular to the surface it is attached to.

Step 5



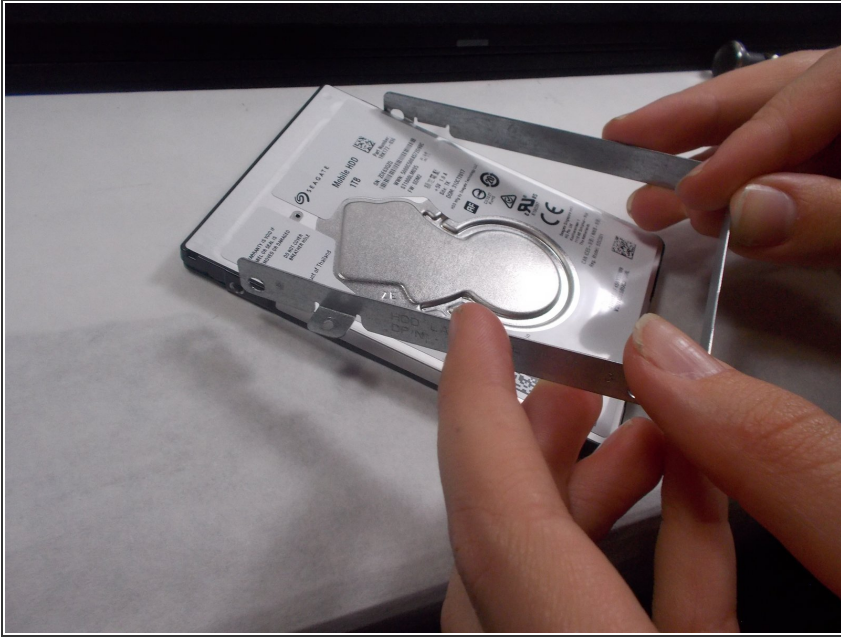
- Remove the hard drive. If you're having difficulty removing it, use a plastic opening tool.

Step 6



- Unscrew the screws on the hard drive casing.

Step 7



- Remove the hard drive casing. If you're having difficulty removing it, use a plastic opening tool.
