INTRODUCTION

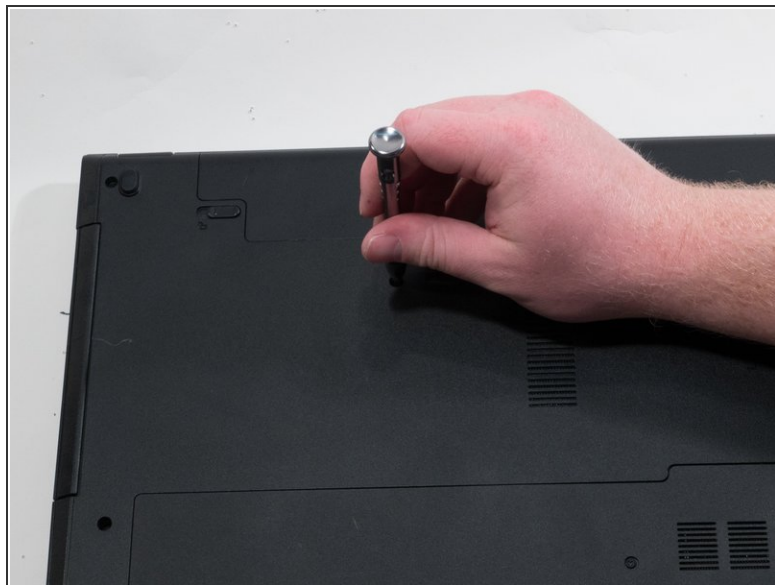

All you need is the standard #0 Phillips Screwdriver head in order to remove the one screw involved with this replacement.

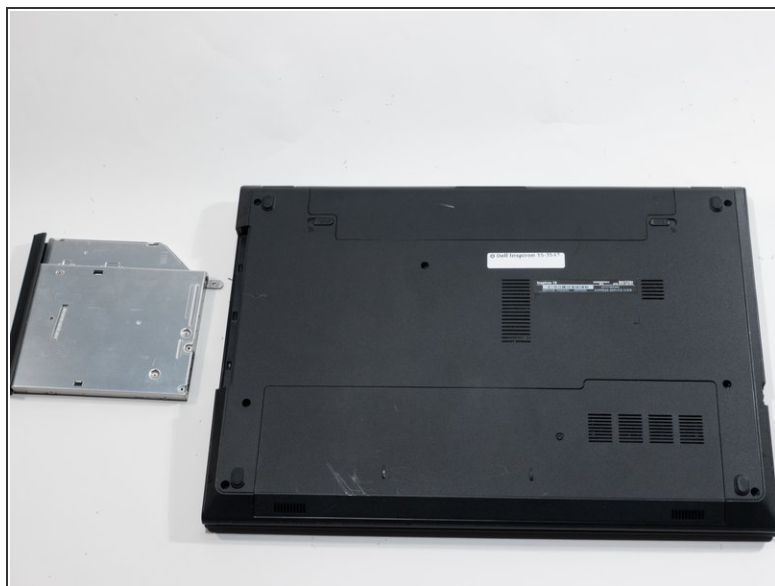
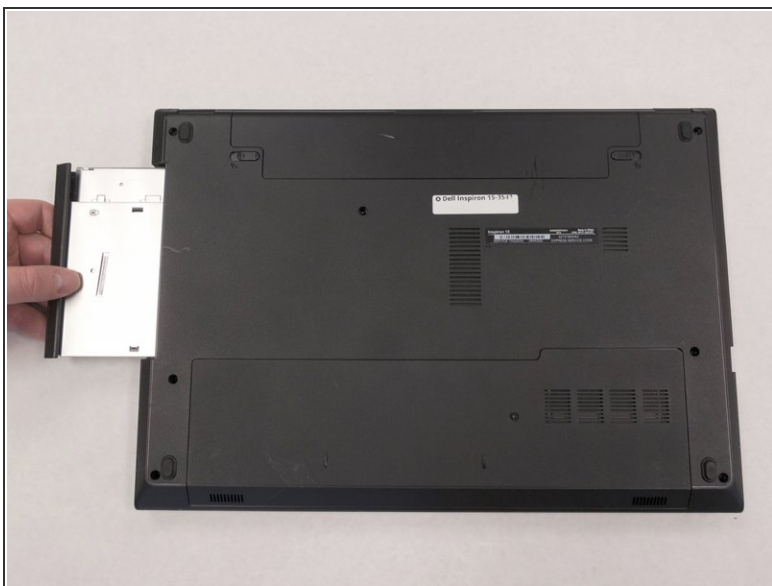
- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Disk Drive



- Flip the device over so the bottom is facing up.
- Using a #0 Phillips screwdriver, remove the 4.0mm screw to the right of the disk drive.

Step 2



- Pull the disk drive out.
