INTRODUCTION

Over time, a laptop's CMOS battery will stop holding its charge and eventually die out. This guide will show how to remove and replace the CMOS battery of the device.

Step 1 — CMOS Battery



- Remove the two 6.5 mm PH1 Philips head screws on the back panel.
- Lift up the small panel from the top, using the plastic opening tools if necessary.

Step 2



- Remove the CMOS battery with the plastic opening tools.
- ⚠ Be careful while prying it open, the battery holder can break if you use too much force.
- ⚠ Do not use metal tools when touching anything that can have an electric charge.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
