INTRODUCTION

You will be able to access wires connecting your screen and replace it if needed.

Step 1 — Keyboard



- Remove battery
- Open screen so that it lies flat.

Step 2



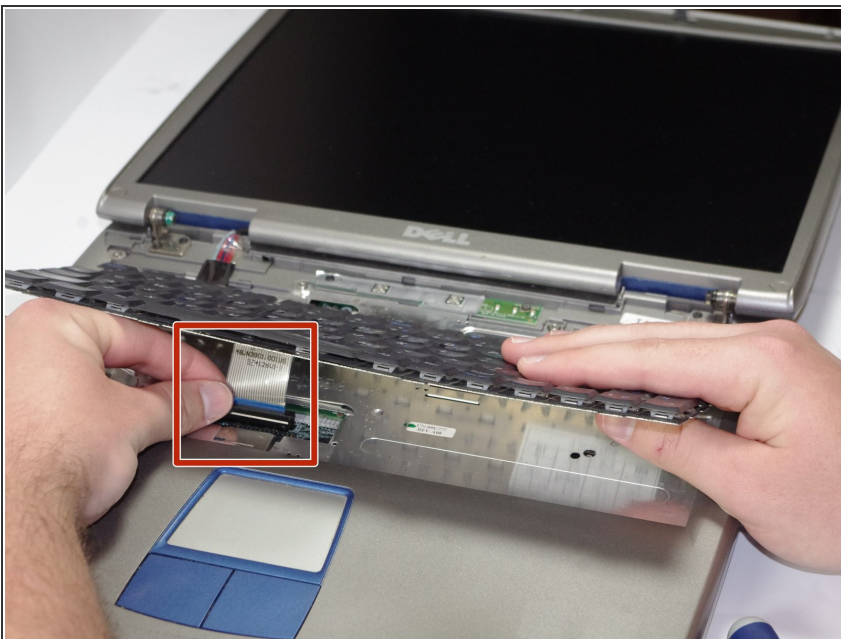
- Starting from the right side of the hinge cover, use the flat end of the spudger to pry up the hinge cover and gently remove it.

Step 3



- Using a Phillips screwdriver remove the four M2 x 3-mm screws holding in the keyboard.

Step 4



- Lift keyboard and detach the interface connector.
- ⓘ Take extra care when removing and handling the keyboard. The key caps on the keyboard are fragile and easily come off.

Step 5 — Screen



- Using a Phillips screwdriver remove the two screws (5.8mm) located at the rear of the laptop.

Step 6



- Detach the screen connector.

Step 7



- Using a Phillips screwdriver remove the four screws (5.8 mm) located at hinges of the screen.

Step 8



- Lift and remove display screen.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
