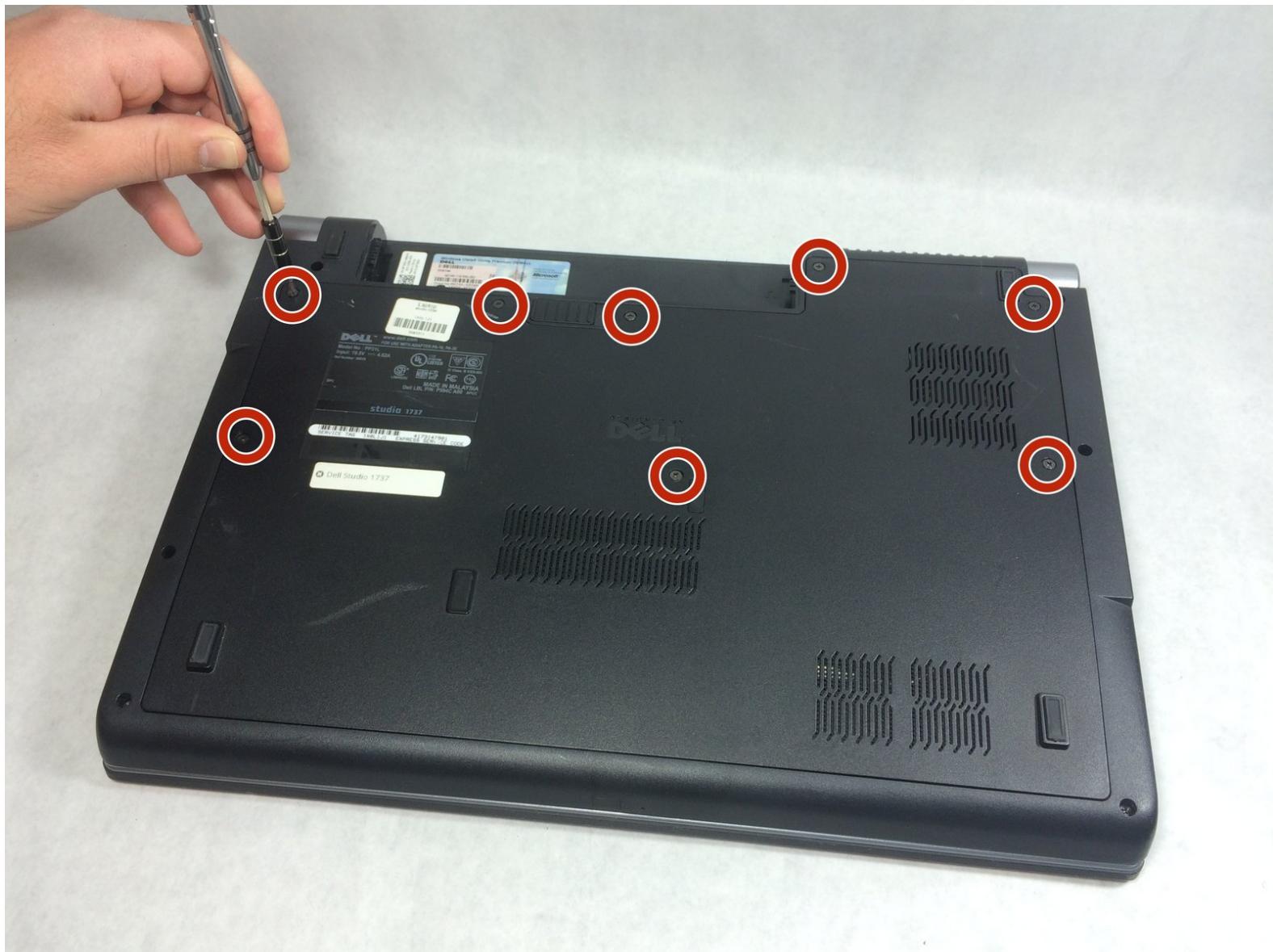




Dell Studio 1737 Back Panel Replacement

Step 1 — Back Panel



- Unscrew the 8 Phillips head screws marked in the photo.
- Even when the screws are fully detached, they will not come out of the panel.
- Use a plastic opening tool to pry the panel away from the laptop body.
- Lift the panel up and away.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
