




# Dell XPS 12 9Q33 mSATA Card Replacement




- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Removing the Battery



- Disconnect the battery cable from the system board.
  - Remove the screws that secure the battery to the palm-rest assembly.
  - Lift the battery, along with its cable, off the palm-rest assembly.
- i** Slide and hold the power switch for about five seconds to ground the system board.
- ↗** If this is all you are doing Follow Step In Reverse if not Go to Next Step.

## Step 2 — Removing the mSATA card



- Remove the screw that secures the mSATA card to the system board.
  - Slide and remove the mSATA card out of the mSATA-card connector.
- ↗** If this is all you are doing Follow Step In Reverse if not Go to Next Step.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
