
## INTRODUCTION

WIFI not working or slow? Replace it (only screwdrivers required).

### TOOLS:


- [T4 Torx Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Wireless Card




- Remove ten 3mm screws from the back cover with a T4 screwdriver.

## Step 2





- Remove the black tape covering the RAM and wireless card with your hands.

## Step 3



- Use a plastic iFixit opening tool to remove the two wires connected to the wireless card.

## Step 4



- Use a **PH00** screwdriver to remove the one 3mm screw that holds the wireless card in place.

## Step 5



- Use your hand to remove the wireless card.
