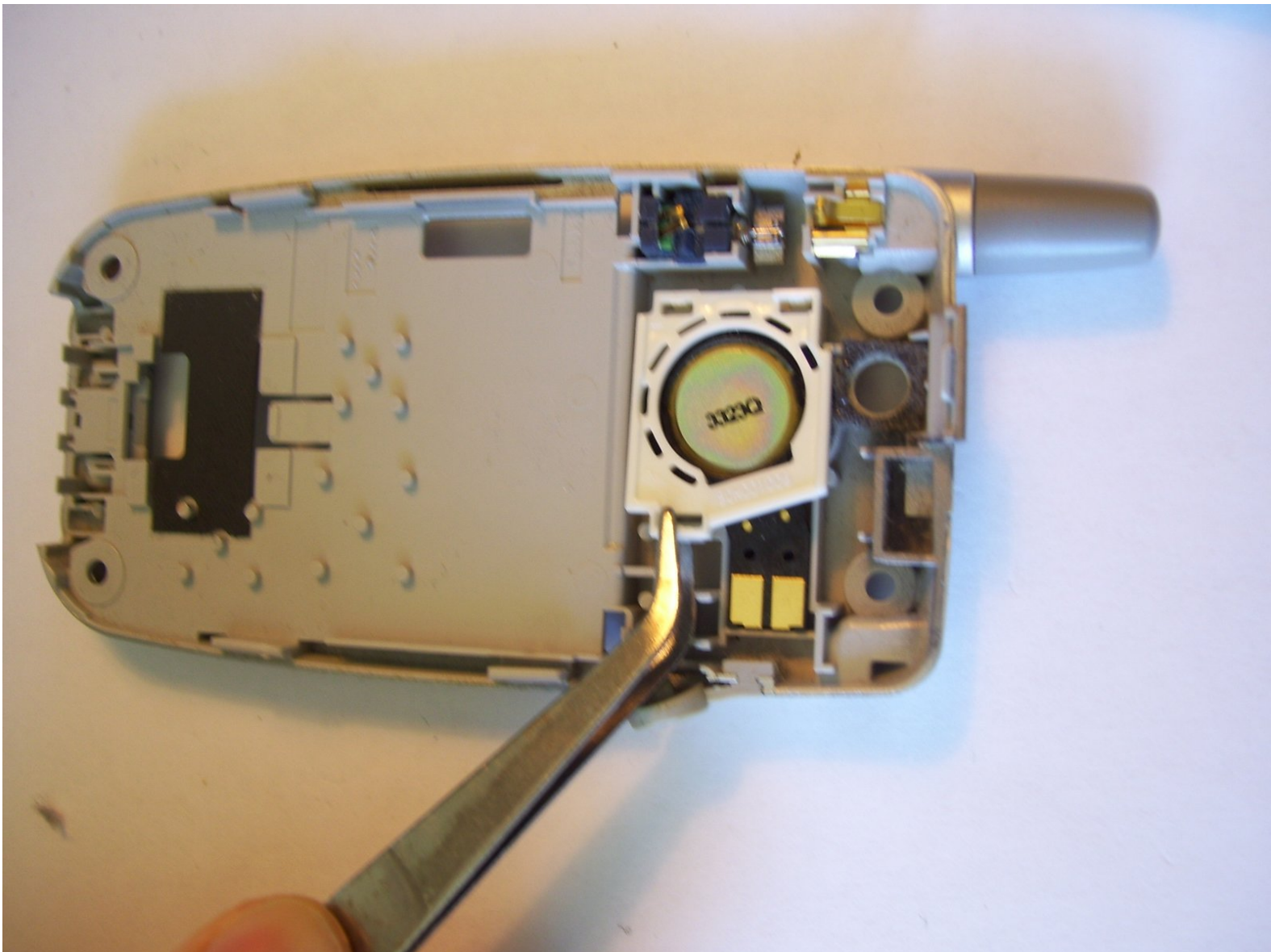




# Disassembling Panasonic GU87 Back Speaker

How to disassemble the speaker from the phone

## TOOLS:

- [Tweezers](#) (1)
- [Tri-wing Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)



## Step 1 — Battery



- Place your hands on the phone as shown in picture. Slightly pull the tab away from the phone with your thumb.

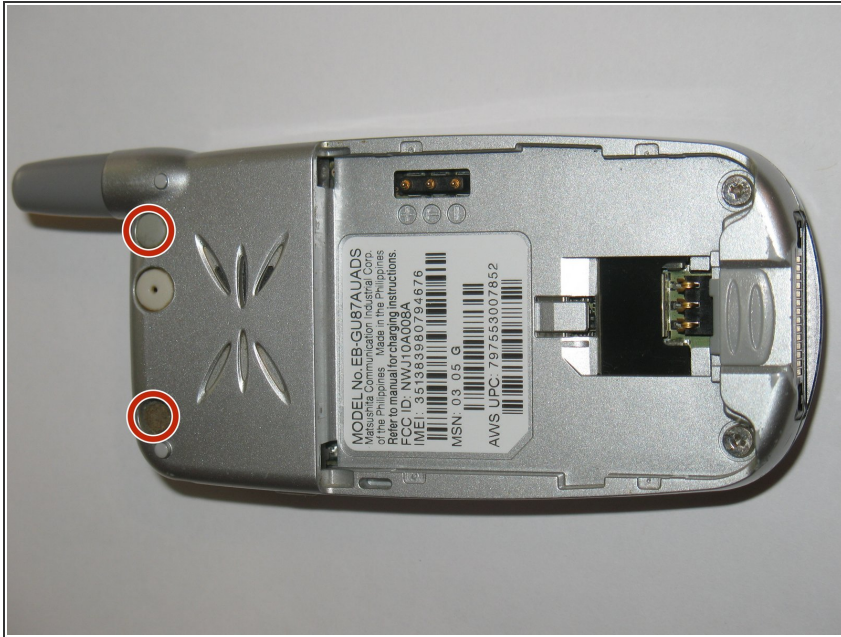
## Step 2



- Lift the battery up from the phone as shown. Replace with a new battery if the old battery has become worn out.



### Step 3 — Disassembling Panasonic GU87 Back cover



- Remove the rubber covers with tweezers.

### Step 4



- Remove all 4 screws from the back of the phone.

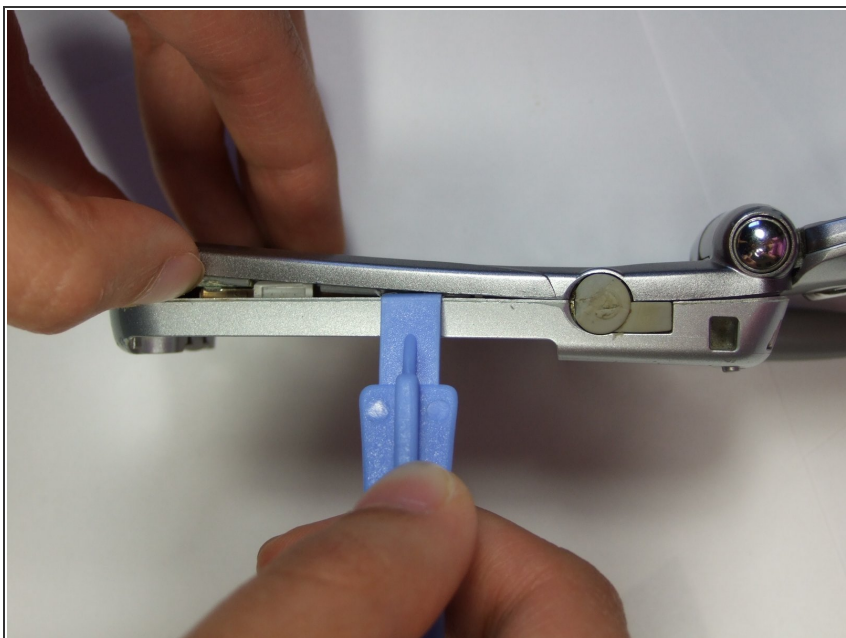


## Step 5



- Use a plastic opening tool to separate the front and back casing.

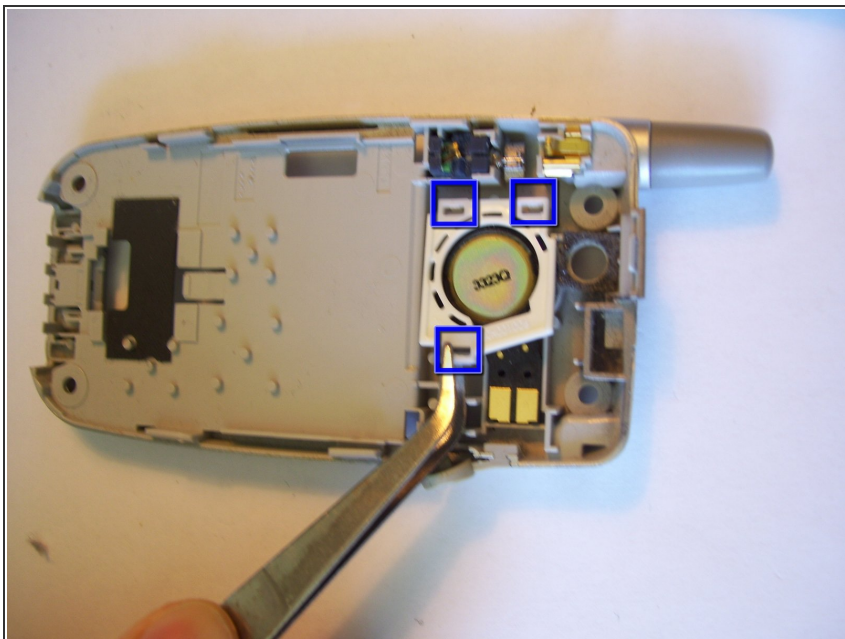
## Step 6



- Put the tool in friction tabs and force down to open the cover as shown in the picture.
- Carefully pop it open the rest of the way with your fingers.

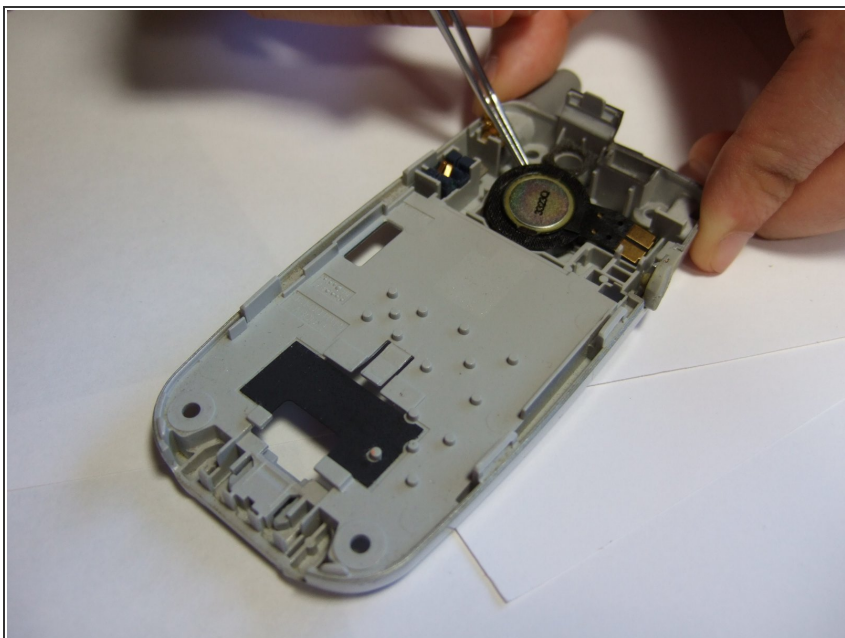


## Step 7 — Back Speaker



- Remove the three tabs on the white plastic square.
- Lift the square plastic out from the speaker to remove

## Step 8



- Use the tweezers to lift the speaker up

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
