## INTRODUCTION

This guide will teach you how to replace the battery if it is dead. It will require no tools and has no hazards.

## Step 1 — Battery



- Pull the battery cover away from the handle by gripping near the thumb groove.

## Step 2



- Gently pull the battery out of the handle.
- ⚠ Excessive force could damage wires.

## Step 3



- Disconnect the battery by pulling the connector away from it.

- Positive first
- Negative second

⚠ When replacing the battery, this order is reversed.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
