



# FLIR FX Camera Stand Battery Replacement

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## INTRODUCTION

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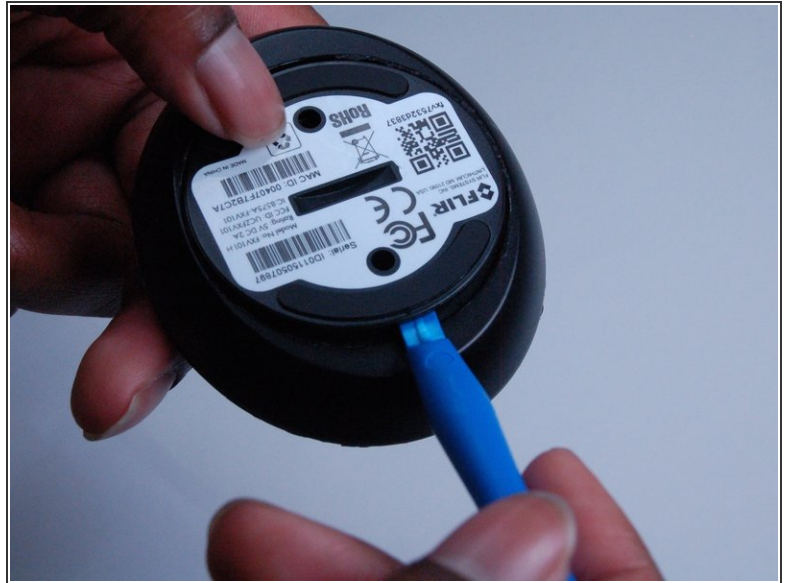

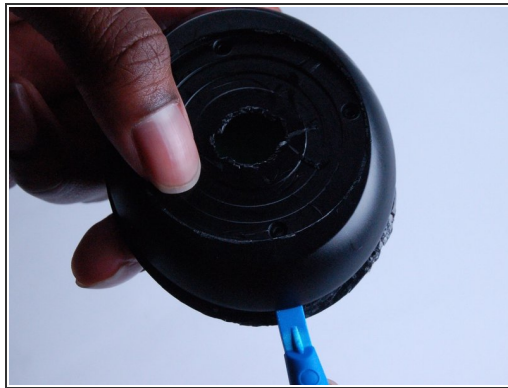
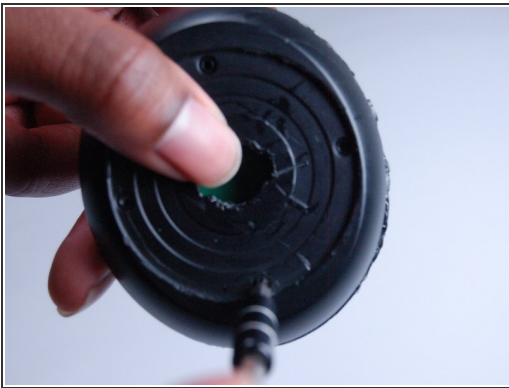

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## Step 1 — Camera Stand Battery



- Use a plastic opening tool to pry off the plastic bottom cover.

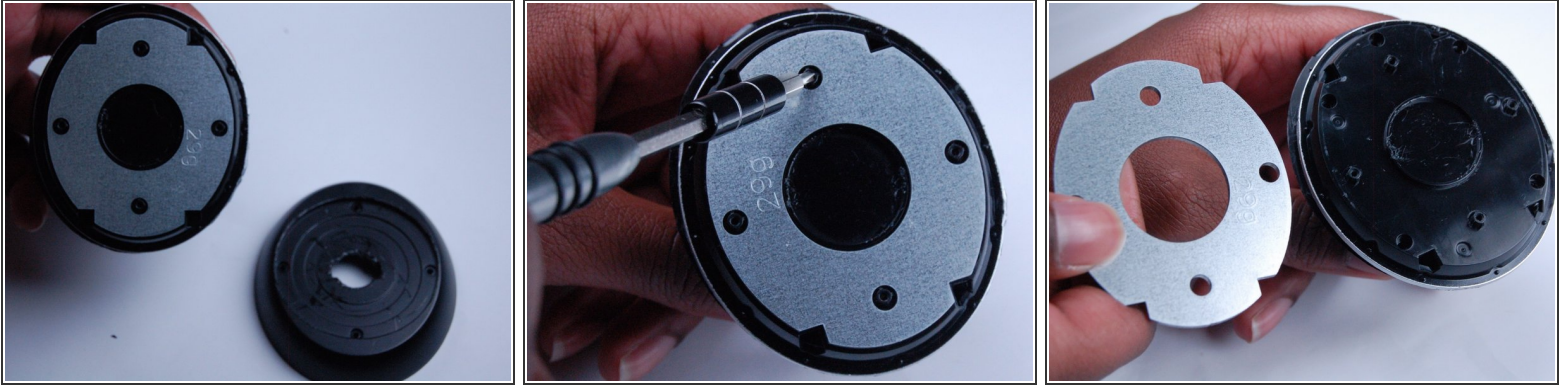
## Step 2



- Unscrew the four screws on the bottom of the stand with a J00 screwdriver.
- Use a plastic opening tool to pry open the bottom of the stand.
- If having a hard time separating the two pieces use the iOpener tool to soften the adhesive under the panel.
- Heat up for 30 seconds. Once it is hot place around the stand to loosen the glue.

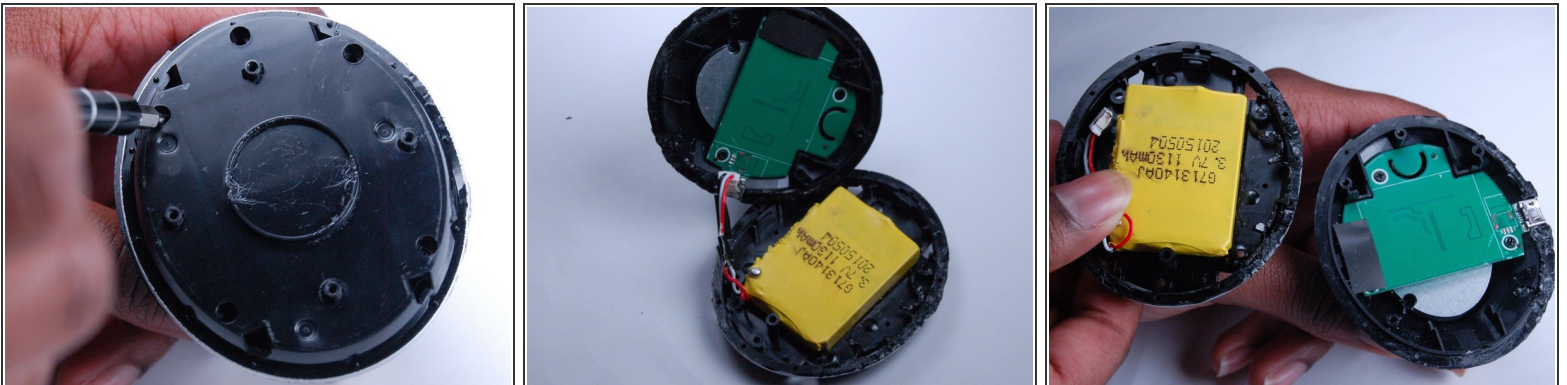


### Step 3



- Once you have separated the two parts, use a J00 screwdriver to unscrew the four 1.2 mm screws which connect the metal piece to the top of the the stand.

### Step 4



- When the metal piece is removed, unscrew the four 1.2 mm Phillips #1 screws on the plastic piece of the stand
- Now separate the top of the stand from the plastic bottom piece.
- Unplug the battery from the stand.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
