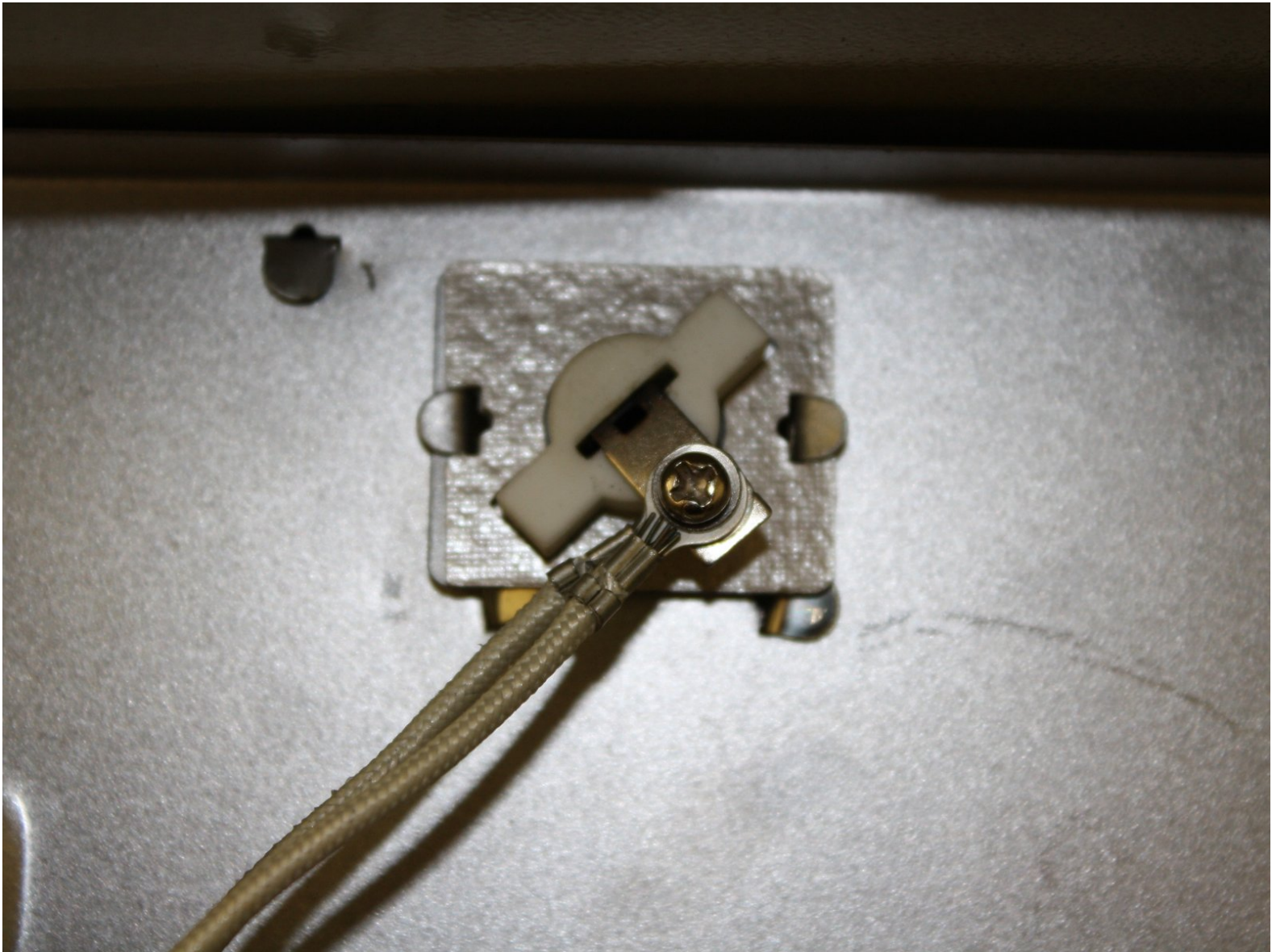




# Farberware FSTO100 Heating Mechanism Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

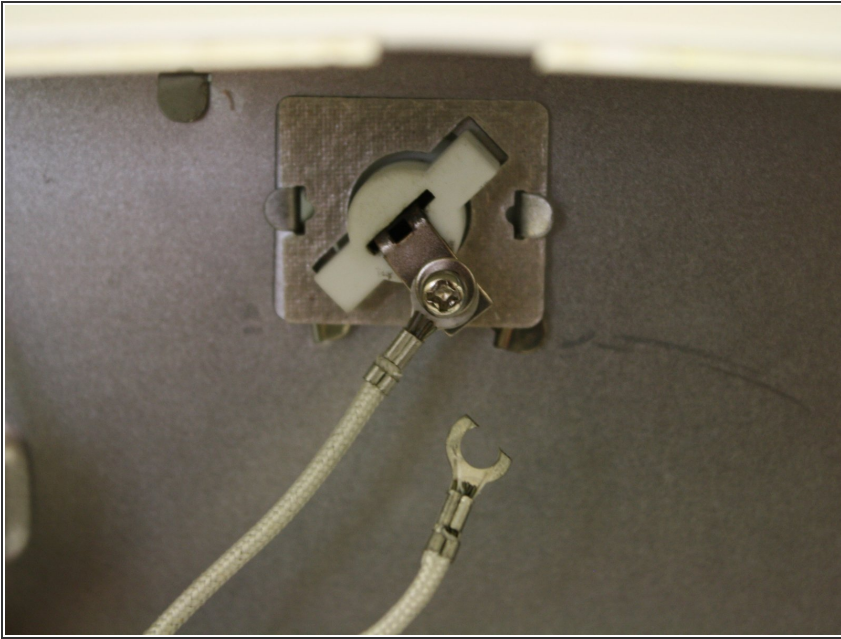
Wire leads are attached inside to heat the toaster oven. Use this guide to repair the heating mechanism to regain use of your toaster oven.

## Step 1 — Heating Mechanism



- ❗ If one of the heating mechanisms isn't working, make sure all wire leads are attached inside the toaster oven.
  - When a broken lead is found, reattach by removing the screw at its original attachment point.

## Step 2



- Make sure that the lead is attached and in contact.



### Step 3



- Retighten screw to secure lead.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
