INTRODUCTION

This fast fix is to fix the buttons on a 2006 Honda Cr-V key fob. It is a very simple and easy fix. You will only need one tool and the replacement part.

TOOLS:

- Micro screwdriver (1)

PARTS:

- Key Fob Buttons (1)

Step 1 — 2006 Honda CR-V Key Fob



- You will need to take the key off the ring.

Step 2



- The second step is to take out the little screw on the back side of the key.

Step 3



- Unclip the back part of your key.


 This part is super fragile.

Step 4



- You will push the buttons from the front side to have the middle piece fall out.

Step 5



- Then you will unclip the middle part. There is one clip on each side of this piece. They are super fragile and can break easily.

Step 6



- Then push the buttons from the front side to push out a rubber insert.

Step 7



- Then peel out the mother chip and replace your rubber insert.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
