Step 1 — Back Light Bulb



- Remove the plastic clips which fasten the outside cover.

Step 2




- Pull out the cover to access the housing

Step 3



- Using wrench to remove the four bolts to open the housing.

Step 4




- Open the housing to access the bulb set and remove it out to replace it.

Step 5





- Put the new light bulb and make sure it is working.

- Place the housing cover on and return the bolts.

Step 7



- Return cover and use the plastic clips to fasten it.
