

Step 1 — Hard Drive




- Flip the laptop with the bottom side up.

Step 2



- Remove the two 6.0mm Philips #00 screws from the back cover.
- Using the plastic opening tool to pry open the back cover

Step 3



- Remove the hard drive by lifting it out, and removing any necessary screws.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
