



Giorgio Armani Watch Butterfly Buckle Clasp Replacement

How to replace a butterfly buckle clasp on a Giorgio Armani watch.

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INTRODUCTION

There are many benefits to repairing your own watch such as cheaper than replacing the whole watch or taking it to a jeweler, and maintaining the sentimental value when repairing it yourself. No prior technical experience is required, just a little patience and literacy!

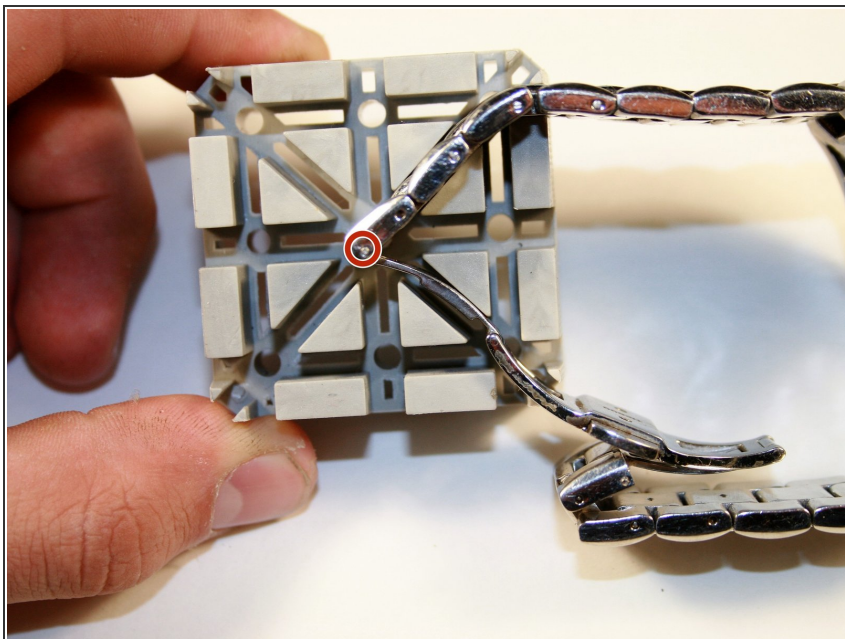

PARTS:

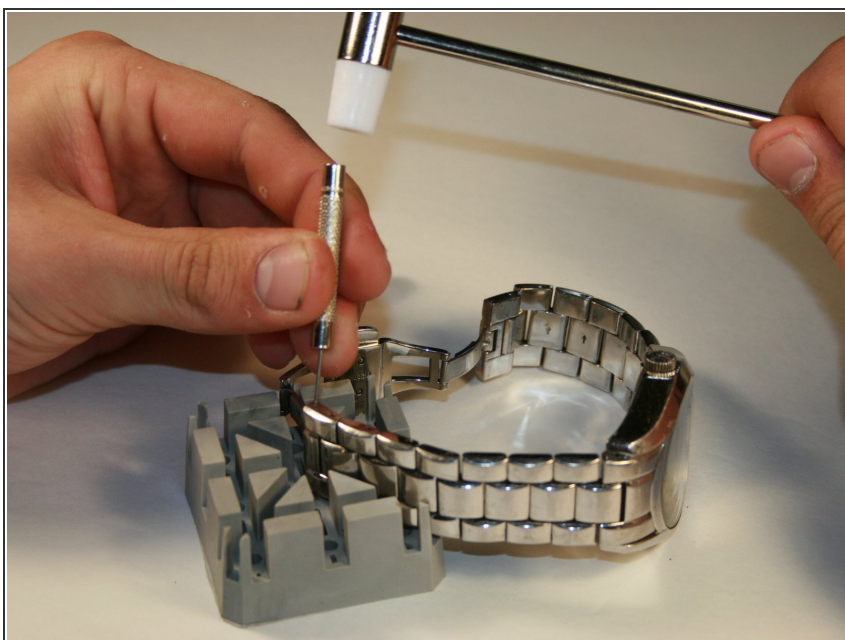
- [Butterfly Buckle Clasp](#) (1)

Step 1 — Butterfly Buckle Clasp



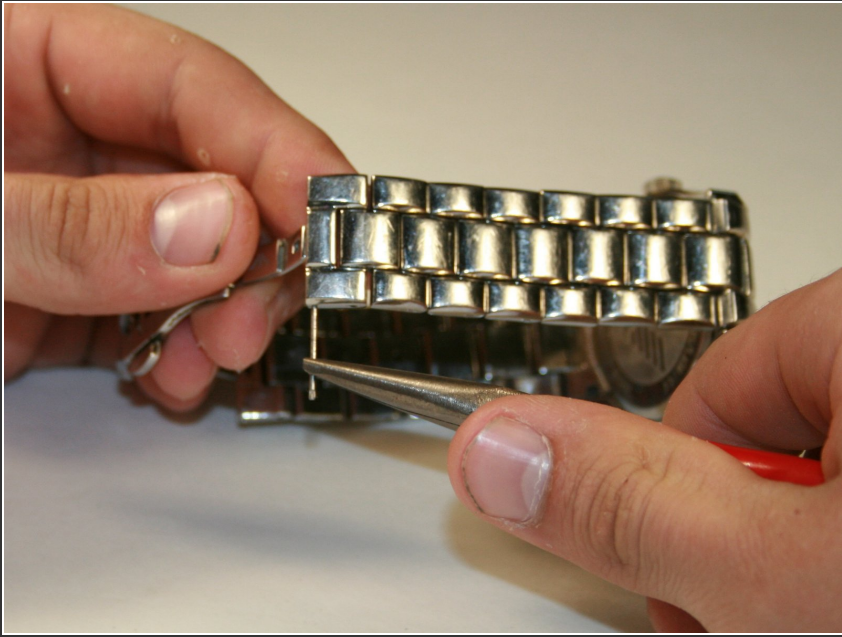
- Place the watch in the band holder.
- Make sure to align the band pin directly over one of the holes.

Step 2



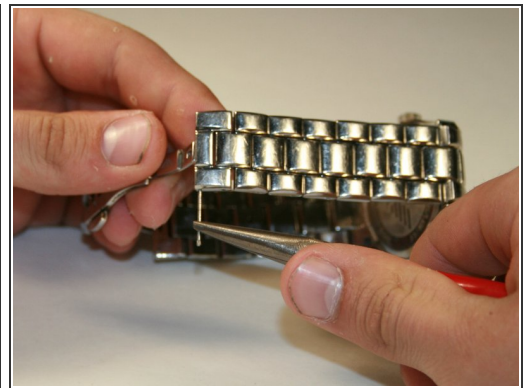
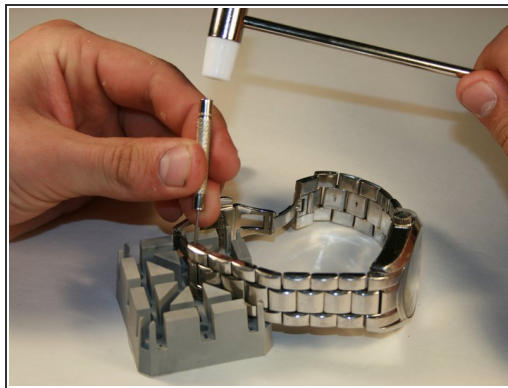
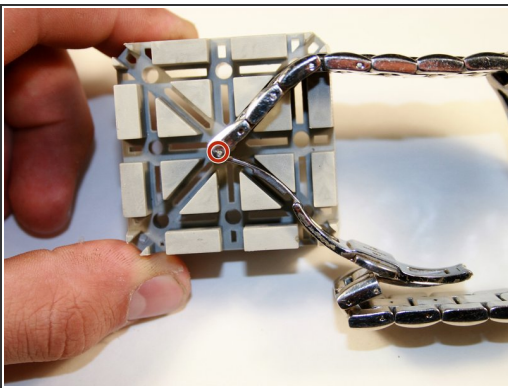
- Use your pin push and rubber mallet to knock it through.

Step 3



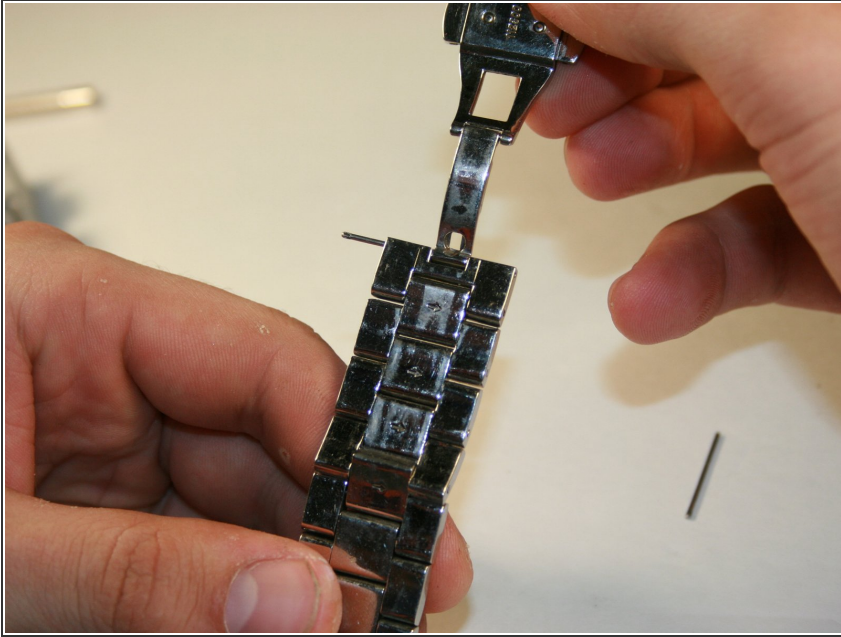
- Use your pliers to pull the pin the rest of the way through.

Step 4



- Repeat steps 1-3 on the other side to fully release the old clasp from the watch.

Step 5



- Slide the pin back in halfway, then reattach both sides of your new clasp to your watch.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
