INTRODUCTION

Step 1 — Battery



- Flip the laptop over so that the bottom is facing you.
- Slide the latch towards the center of the laptop so the unlock emblem appears.

Step 2



- Place your finger on the left latch and slide it towards the center of the laptop to remove the battery.

Step 3



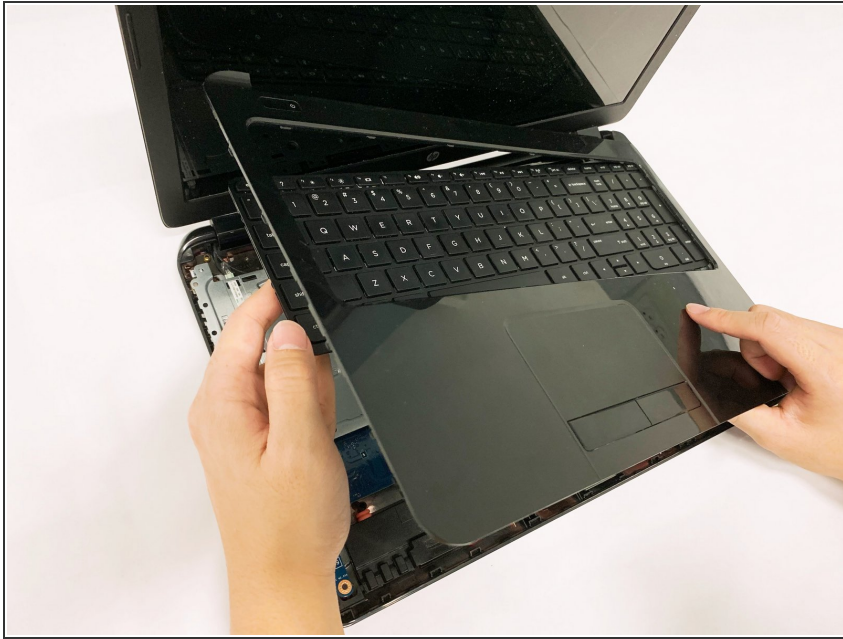
- Remove the battery from the laptop.

Step 4 — Keyboard



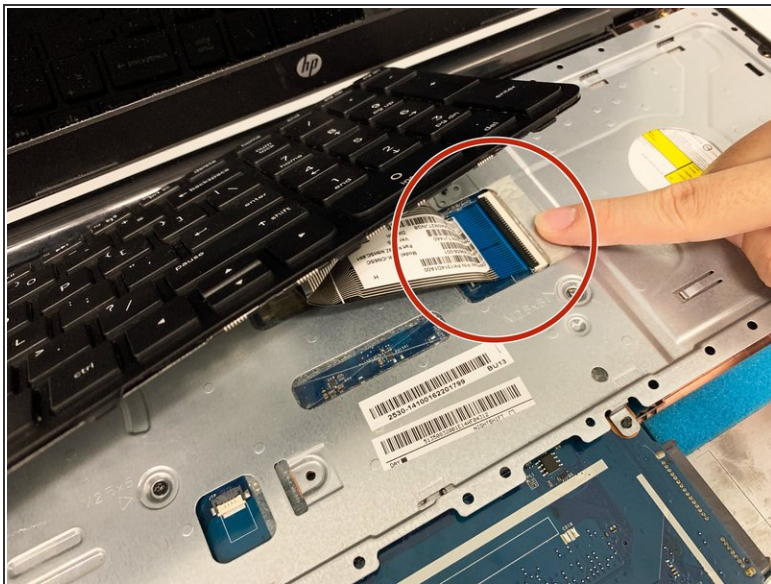
- Use the plastic opening tool to lift the panel with the keyboard.

Step 5



- Take the keyboard and the section of the panel surrounding the keyboard apart.

Step 6



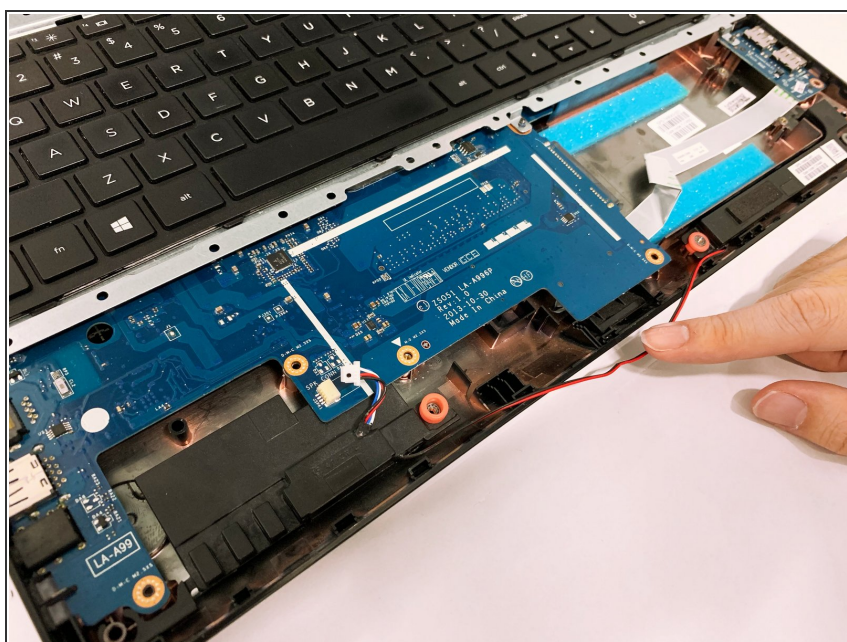
- Lift the flip covering the connection port and remove the connecting strip to detach the keyboard from the motherboard.

Step 7 — Speaker



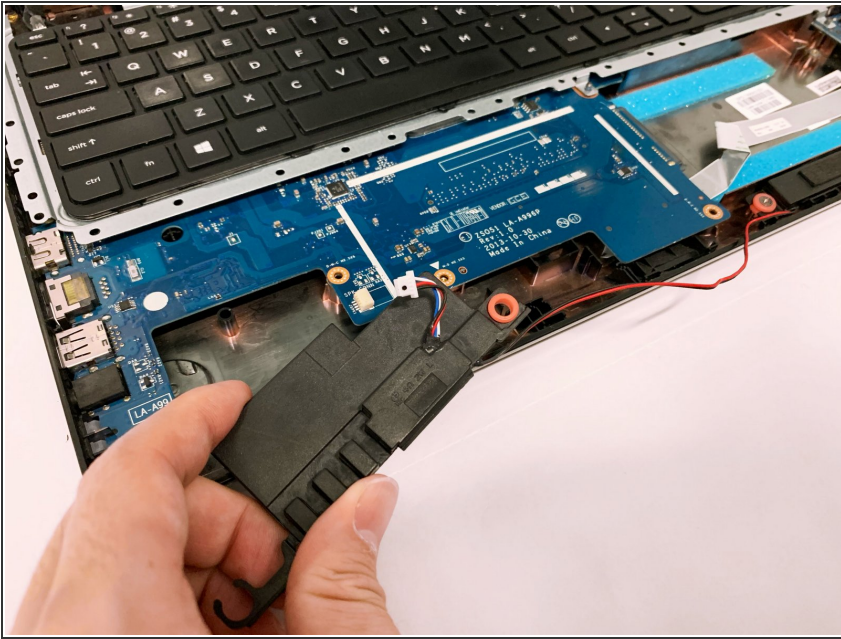
- Detach the clip on the speaker from the port on the motherboard.

Step 8



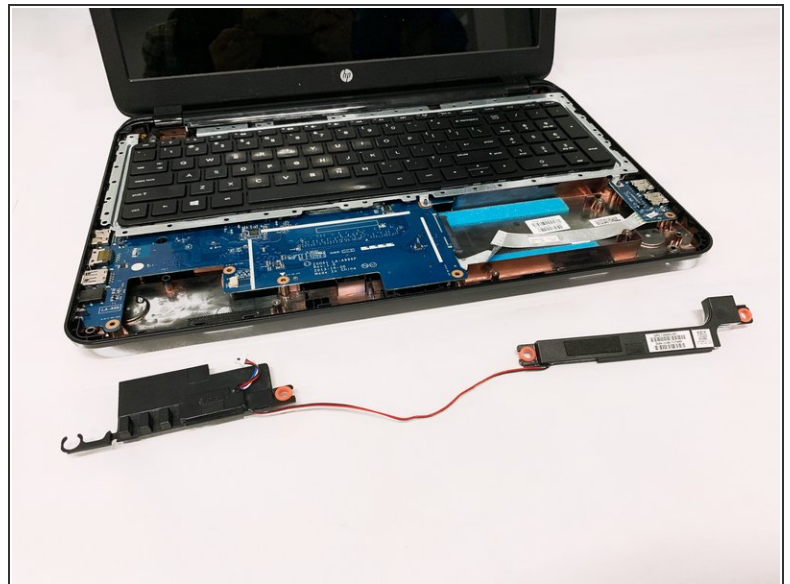
- Pull out the wire connecting the two speakers under the motherboard.

Step 9



- Pull the left speaker out and hold the rubber ring.

Step 10



- Pull the right speaker out and hold the rubber ring.
