How to replace a broken keyboard on an HP computer

TOOLS:

- Essential Electronics Toolkit (1)

Step 1 — Keyboard



- First make sure you have a clear work space

⚠ Make sure you have all of the tools to do this job! If not you may break something else doing this Repair


ⓘ Not all the tools in the picture I needed.

Step 2



- My keyboard is kind of bad so the general idea is to get a flat bladed screwdriver under Neath of the old keyboard not the keys it may help if you take all of the old keys off around the sides

Step 3




- pry Up on the old keyboard until you see the 5 pins pop up out of place once all 5 come undone the old key board should come right out

Step 4



- Now the old keyboard is out.

Step 5



- Put the pins of the new keyboard in then put it back into place as the old one was.

Step 6



- That's the end your laptop should be working just right now one thing I forgot to mention was you had to plug the cable on the keyboard back in if you did not do so your keyboard definitely will not work.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
