



HP 8 1401 Rear-Facing Camera Replacement

In this guide, you will learn how to replace the rear-facing camera of your HP tablet.

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
INTRODUCTION

This guide will help you if your rear-facing camera is cracked or damaged. You may need to pull a little bit to remove the camera, it is well secured in the tablet.

TOOLS:

- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)
- [T4 Torx Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [ESD Safe Tweezers Blunt Nose](#) (1)
- [Spudger](#) (1)

Step 1 — Back Panel



- Using a Torx T4 screwdriver, remove the four 5 mm screws on the back panel.

Step 2




- Insert the tip of a plastic opening tool in the seam between the front and back panels.

Step 3



- Slide the plastic opening tool around all edges of the device until the back panel detaches.
- Lift off the back panel.

Step 4 — Rear-Facing Camera



- Place the tip of your spudger under the edge of the press fit connector, and pry the connector straight up from its socket.
- Lift the rear-facing camera out of its compartment using the tweezers.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
