



HP Chromebook 14 G5 Battery Replacement

Use this guide to remove the battery in the HP Chromebook 14 G5.

INTRODUCTION

If your HP Chromebook 14 G5 is not able to hold a charge, you most likely have a dead battery, which requires replacement.

A functional battery provides power to your laptop. Eventually, laptop batteries will rapidly drain after going through a repeated amount of charge cycles. If you notice significant drops in battery percentage, you should replace your battery.

A punctured battery can cause danger. If your battery is swollen, be sure to take appropriate precautions as soon as possible.

Make sure to power down your device before you begin.


- [Metal Spudger](#) (1)

Step 1 — Battery






- Remove nine 2.5mm screws embedded in the back cover using the Phillips #0 screwdriver.
- Remove the back cover using a spudger.

Step 2



- Remove the 4.1mm screws using the Phillips #00 screwdriver.

Step 3



- Disconnect the FFC.
- Remove the battery from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
